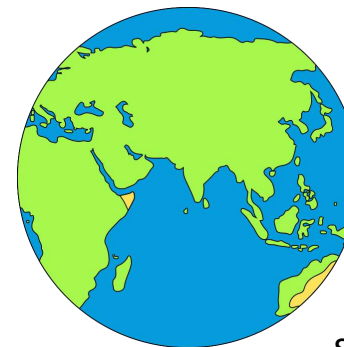


The Shaytan (Iblis) became the enemy of Adam ﷺ. Shaytan would try and trick Adam ﷺ and make him disobey Allah.



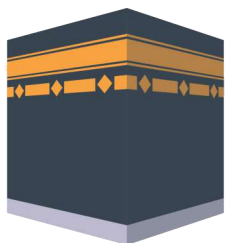
The Tree

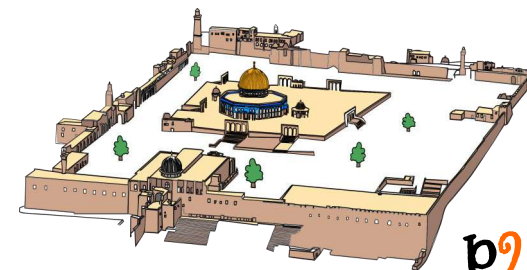


Earth

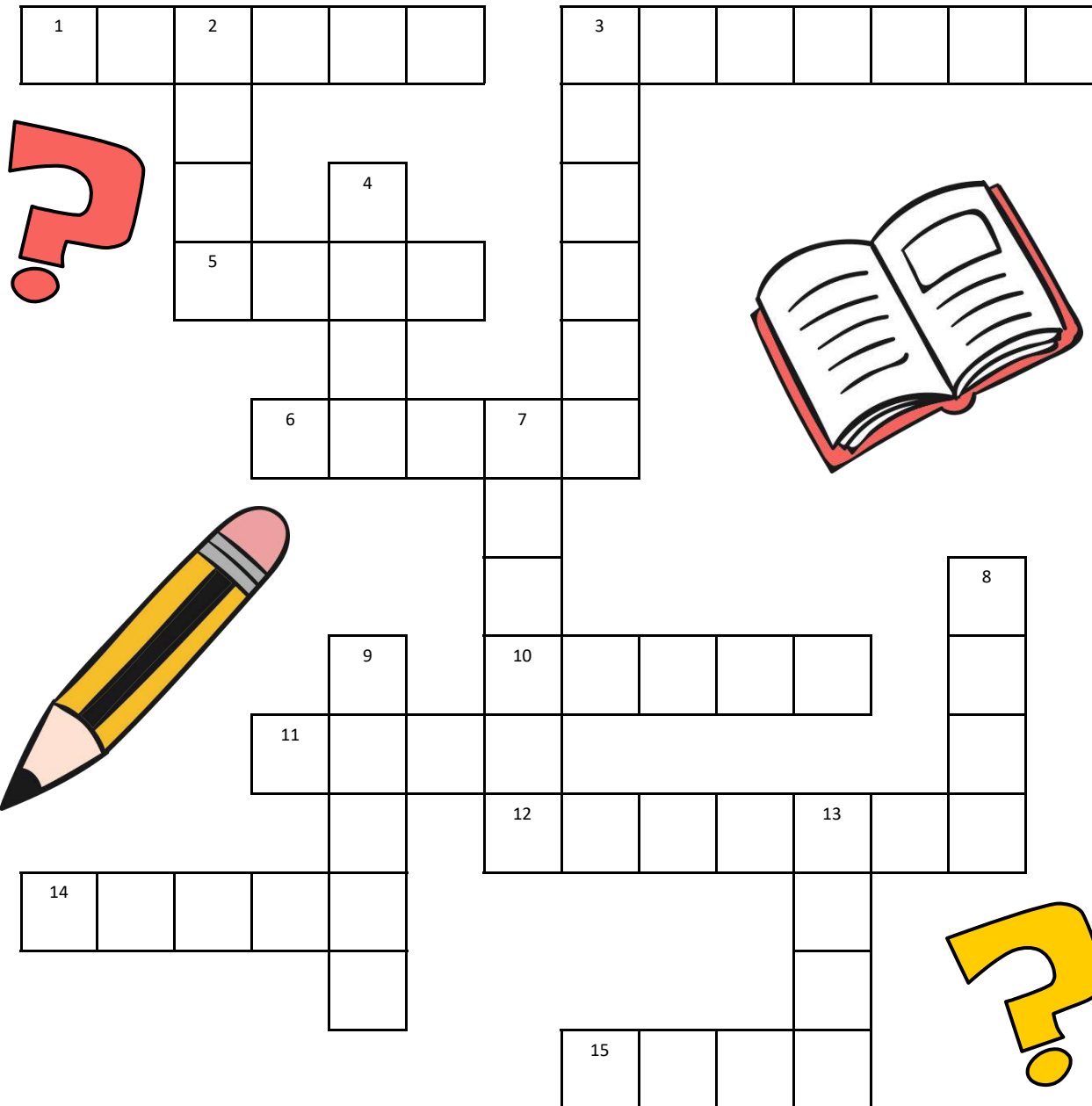

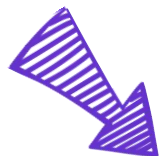

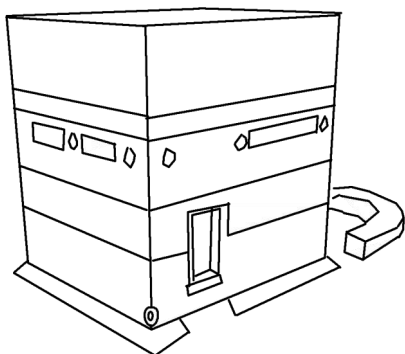


From Makkah to Jerusalem

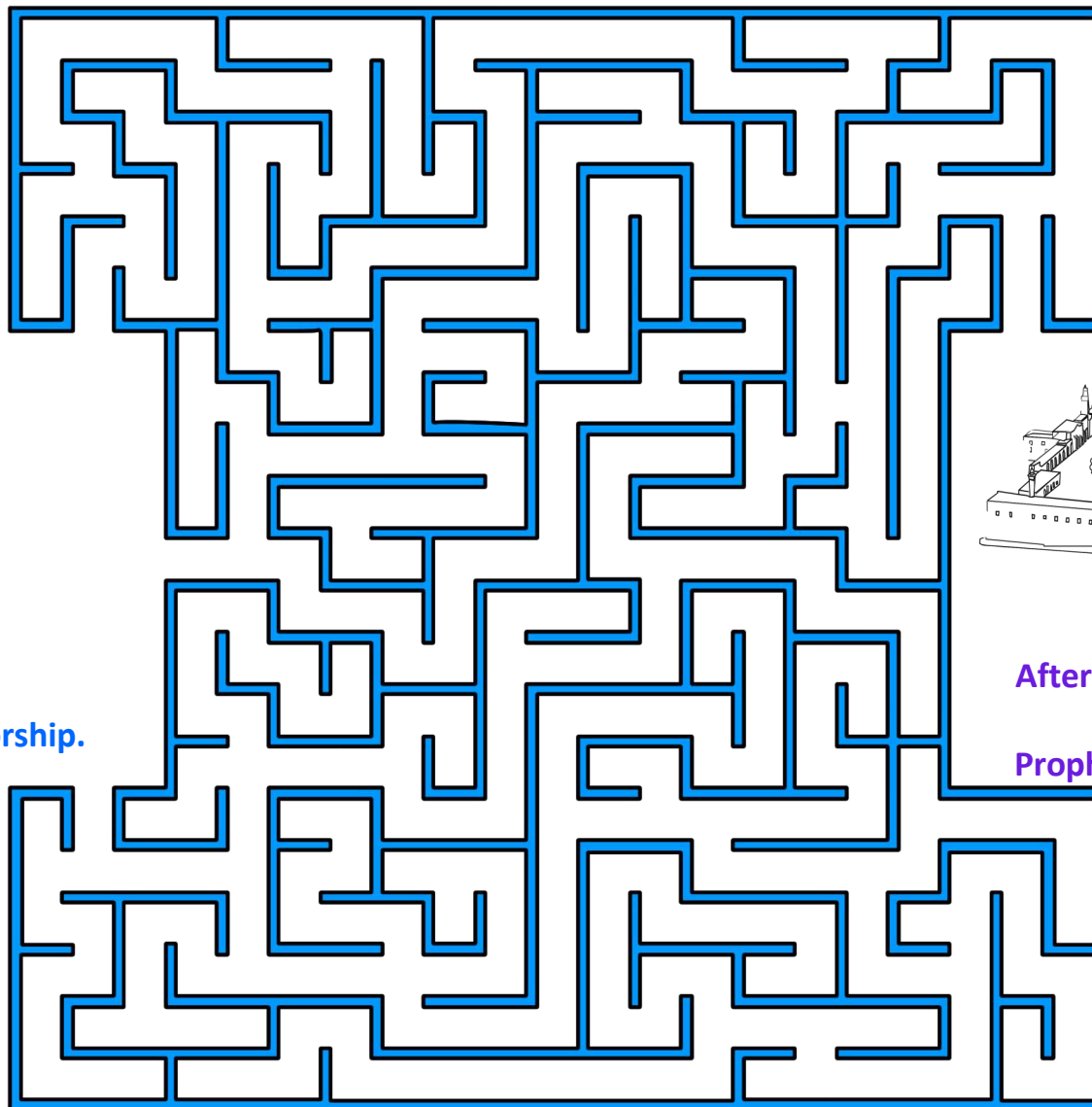


The Ka'bah

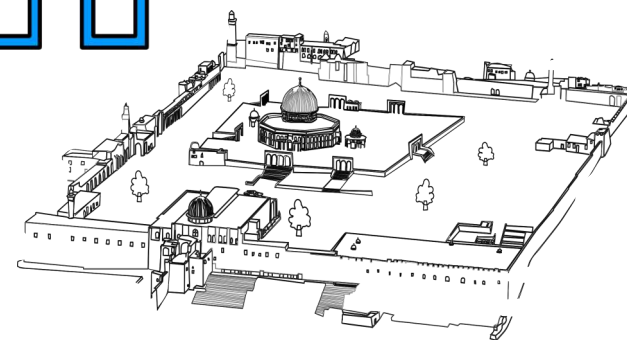


This was the first place of worship.

The Ka'bah was built in Makkah, which was just a desert. It was a very sacred and holy place. Even today it remains the most important place on Earth.



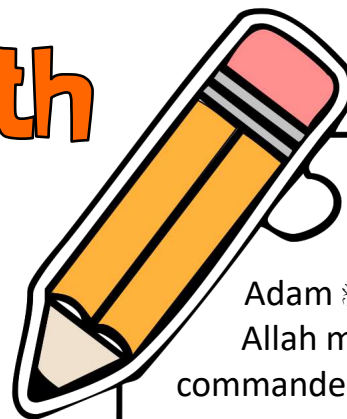
Masjid Al-Aqsa

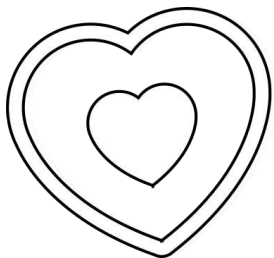
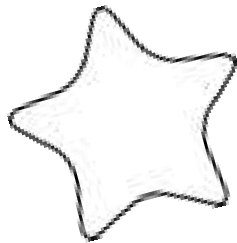
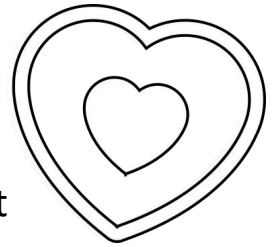
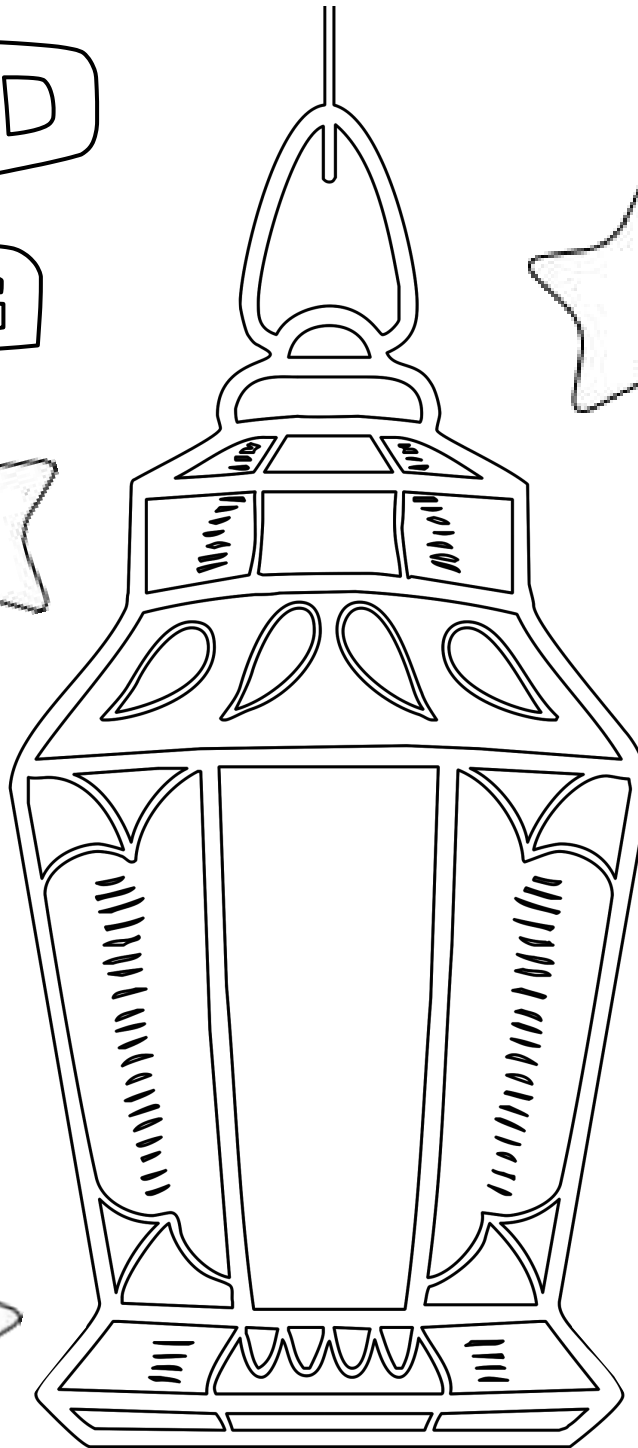
If you can't travel to Masjid Al-
