We should not let our power or wealth make us selfish, proud or arrogant. We should not be extravagant. We should help others and be humble.






Adha Time Adhan

Sulayman the Magnificent


Sulayman was the tenth sultan of the Ottoman Empire who died in 973AH (1566CE)

Hussein bin Talal was King of Jordan until his death in 1419AH (1999CE)





Our story starts in the middle of a longer story. The story is called al-Isra wal-Miraj.





As Prophet Muhammad 🍇 descended through the heavens, Musa Kele stopped him at the sixth heaven. He asked what


Allah had given him.

From here. Prophet Muhammad ﷺ returned back to Makkah. This return







The main purpose of a masjid is for Salah. This is the best type of worship. Whenever we go to the masjid, we must make sure to perform our Salah really well.


We should never waste this chance to perform Salah.



When someone is doing something good, then we should also try and help. Good work includes something as simple as helping your mum or as difficult as helping to build a masjid.










Allah chose the best of the people and made them into prophets. The prophets would teach their people about Allah.

Prophet Musa


Musa 🕮 saved his people from the Pharaoh in Egypt. When Musa will struck his staff on the ground, the sea parted so he could pass through with his people safely.





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FROM JERUSALEM

After returning from Al-Miraj, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ mounted Buraq and returned to Makkah.

On the return journey, he saw the caravans making their way through the desert. The camels were carrying their goods, later to be sold in the markets of Makkah.

TO MAKKAH

In Makkah, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ told the people about this amazing journey (Al-Isra).

Prophet Muhammad described the caravan making its way to Makkah. Days later, when the caravan arrived, it was exactly as Prophet Muhammad had described it.





The Night Journey

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was sleeping in Makkah, not too far from the sacred Ka'bah. He was woken up by Angel Jibrael ﷺ.

Angel Jibrael Real asked our Prophet Muhammad Real to go on a special night journey. I know you might think a trip in the desert sounds fun. This was no ordinary journey.

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ mounted Buraq, which is an animal from Jannah. The best way to describe Buraq is that it's like a white horse but smaller. As you know, Jannah is amazing, and so are the things inside. Buraq could travel so fast, faster than anything on earth. With one single step, it travelled further than the eye can see.

Jannah is a reward from Allah for people who follow Allah's guidance. There are things in Jannah that no heart can understand, no mind can imagine, and no eye has seen.


Buraq was from Jannah. It was also truly amazing.

We should read the stories of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and learn about the great events in his life.










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DAY 4: Marwani Masjid
