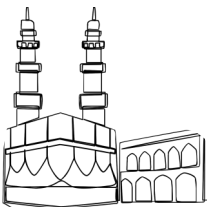
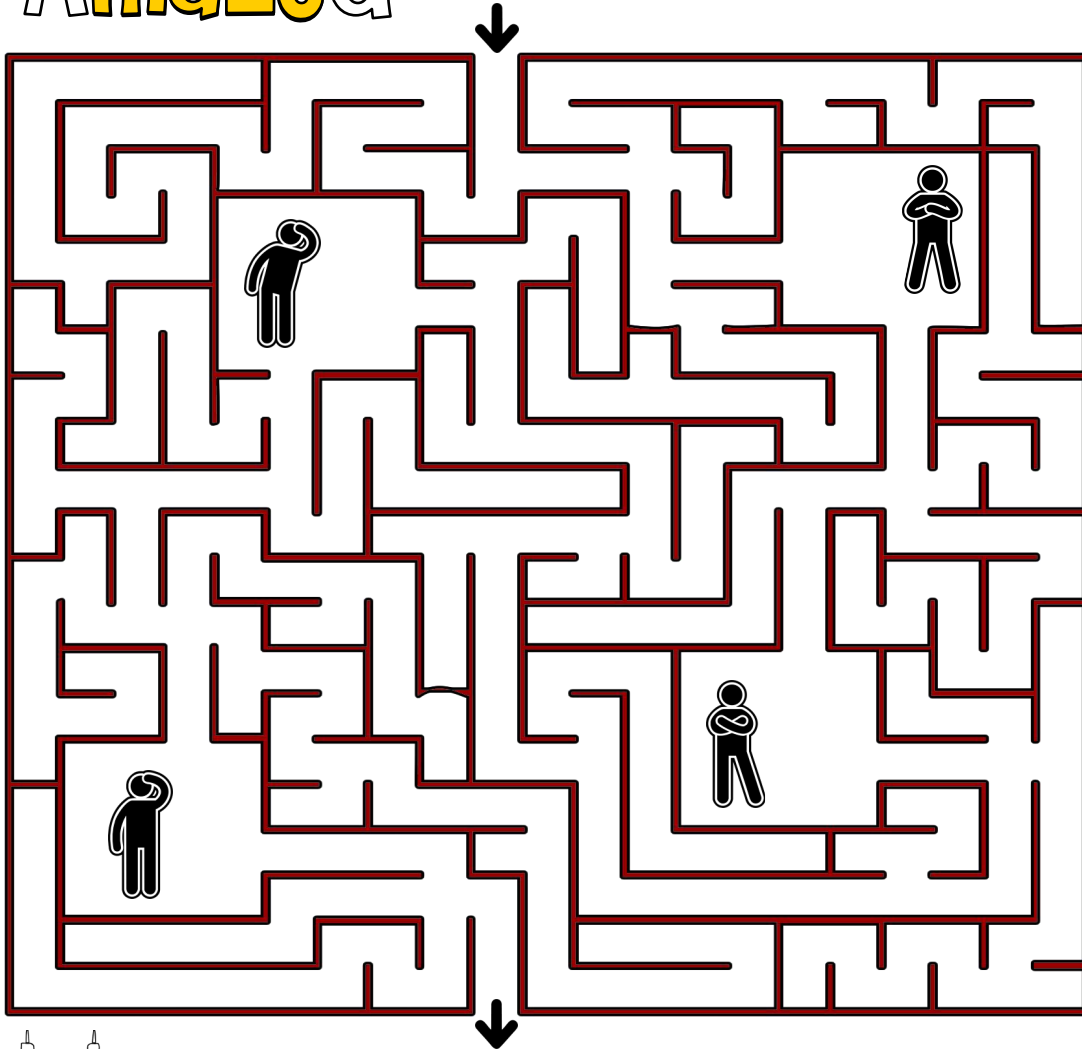






Amazed

The people of Makkah kept a close eye on anyone coming to Makkah. They didn't want people to speak with the Muslims and learn about Islam.

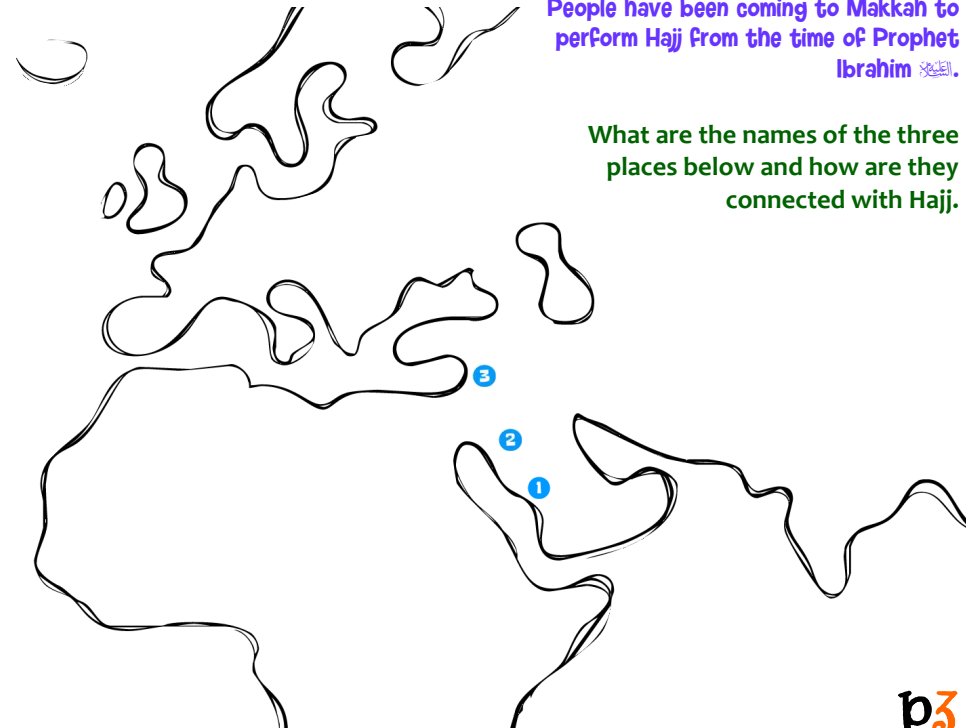

People have been coming to Makkah to perform Hajj from the time of Prophet Ibrahim ﷺ.

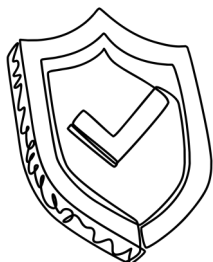

Nusaybah  heard about a vast army that had set off from Makkah. It was marching towards Madina, intending to fight the Muslims.

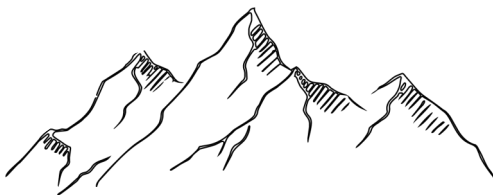
The Makkans had attacked the Muslims before at Badr. With the help of Allah, the Muslims were victorious at Badr.

only seven hundred. They had decided to march out of Madina, near the mountain of Uhud, and meet the Makkan army there.

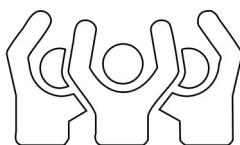


The Muslims made camp there and got ready to face the Huge Makkan army.

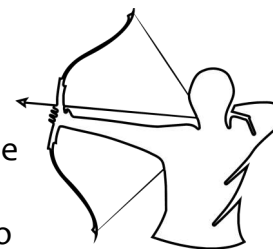


When the battle started, the Muslims defended themselves with bravery and courage. They   fought as hard as   they could.



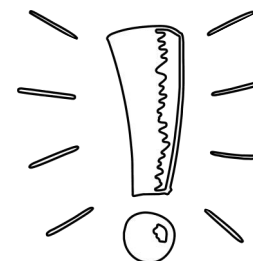
Before long, they were winning.

Some of the Muslims had a critical job. These were the archers who used arrows to defend the army.



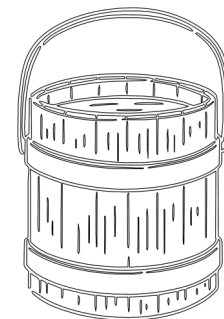
Prophet Muhammad  told them not to move from this small hill.

the injured Muslims.

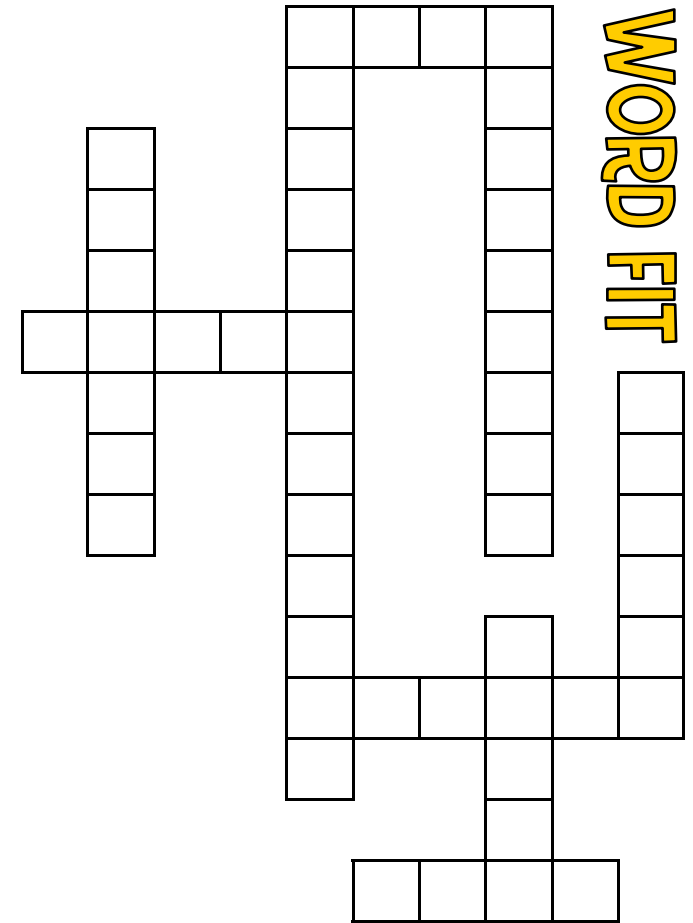
She noticed that the Makkans were heading towards Prophet Muhammad . There were very few Muslims close to our Prophet Muhammad .

This was the bravery of this amazing Sahabiyyah Nusaybah bint Kaab .



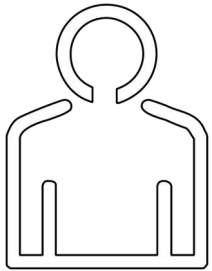


QUALITIES OF NUSAYBAH ﷺ

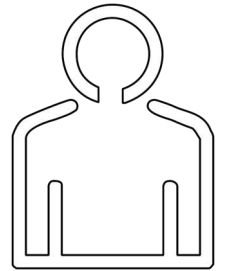

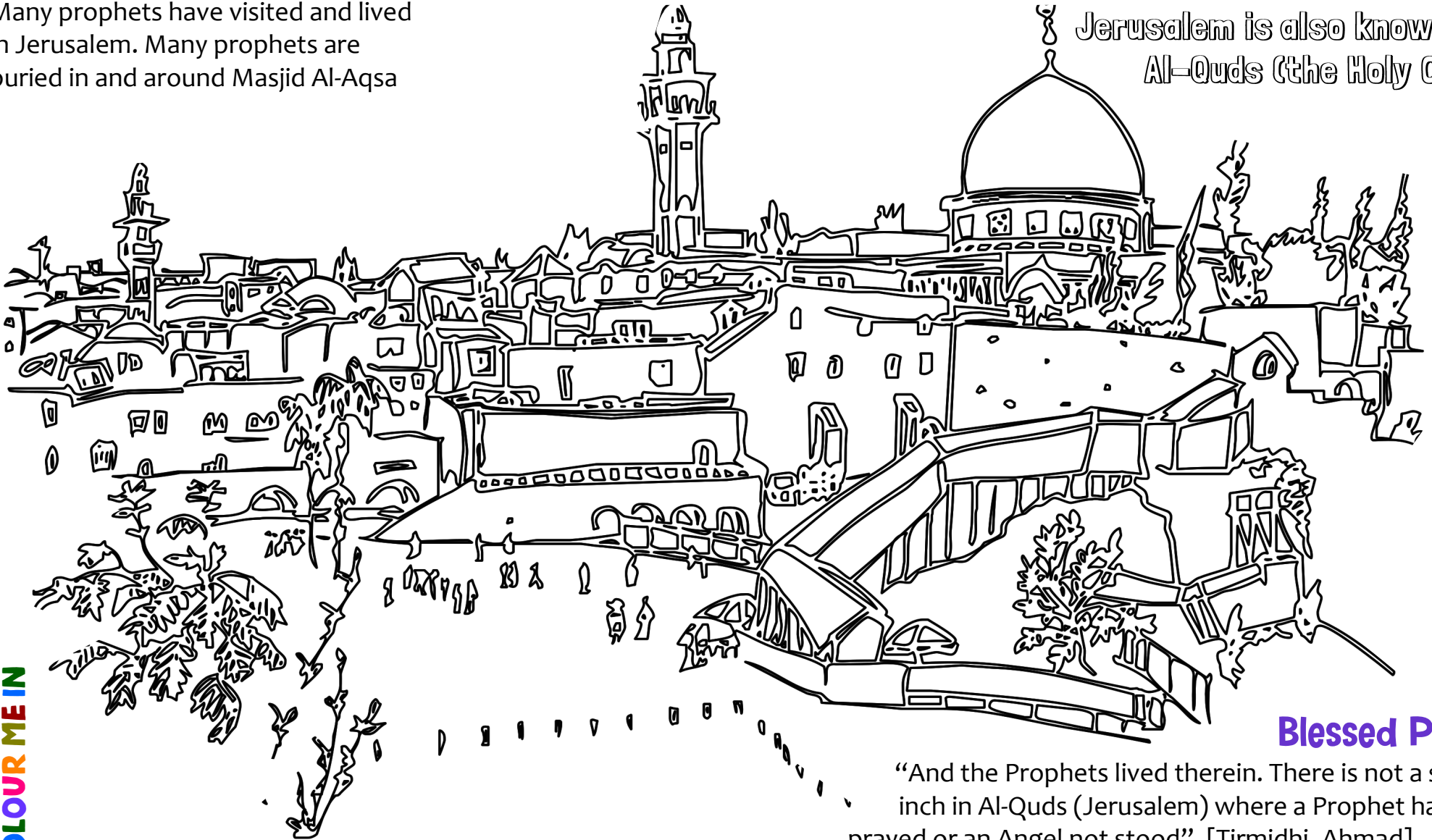

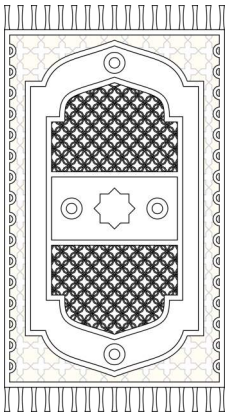
Many prophets have visited and lived in Jerusalem. Many prophets are buried in and around Masjid Al-Aqsa

Jerusalem is also known as Al-Quds (the Holy One).

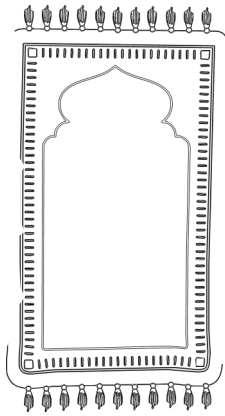

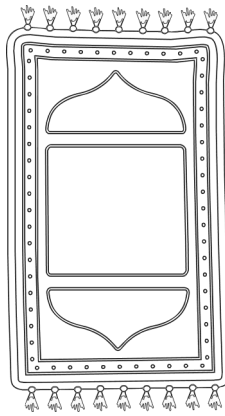

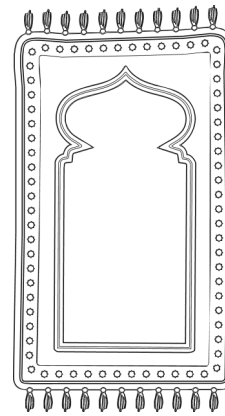
This masjid is not a single building but an area of land



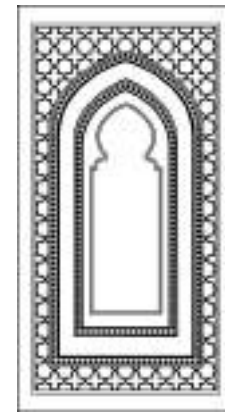
The Qibla (direction of prayer).



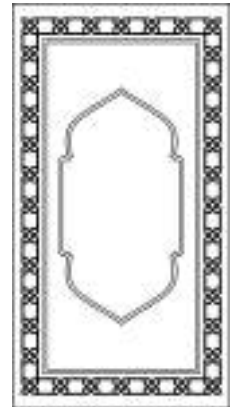
All the prophets prayed together here.



The First Qibla (direction of prayer).



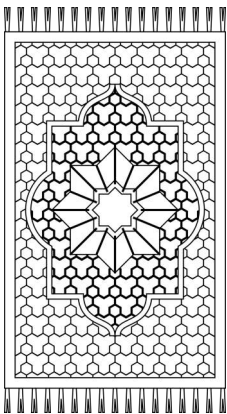
People perform Hajj here.



The third holiest Masjid.



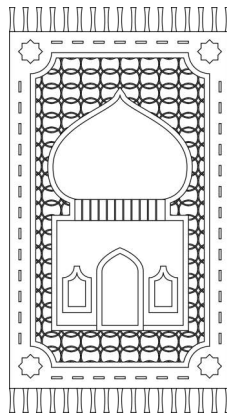

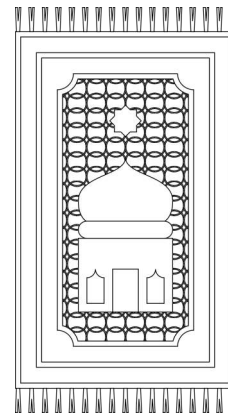

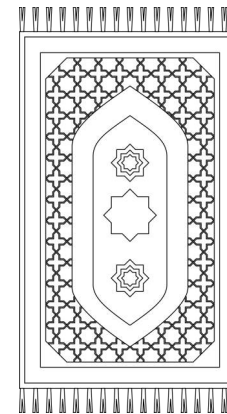

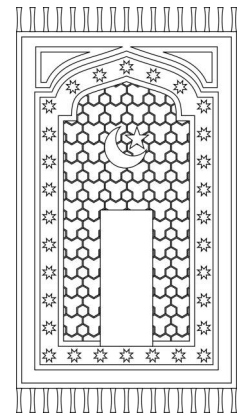

Nusaybah ﷺ was extremely brave. She would help the Muslim soldiers by bandaging their wounds and giving them water.

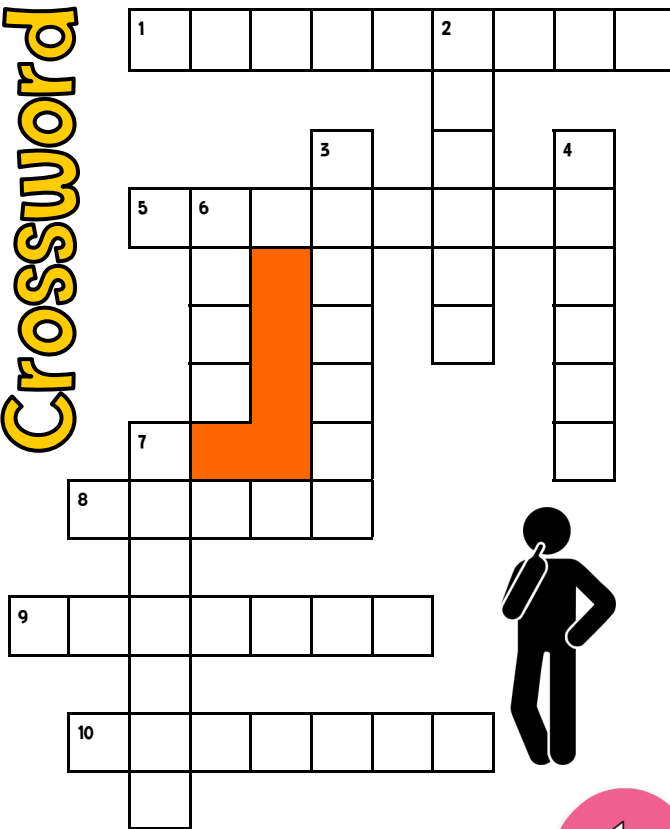
She lifted the shield and defended our Prophet ﷺ at battle of Uhud.

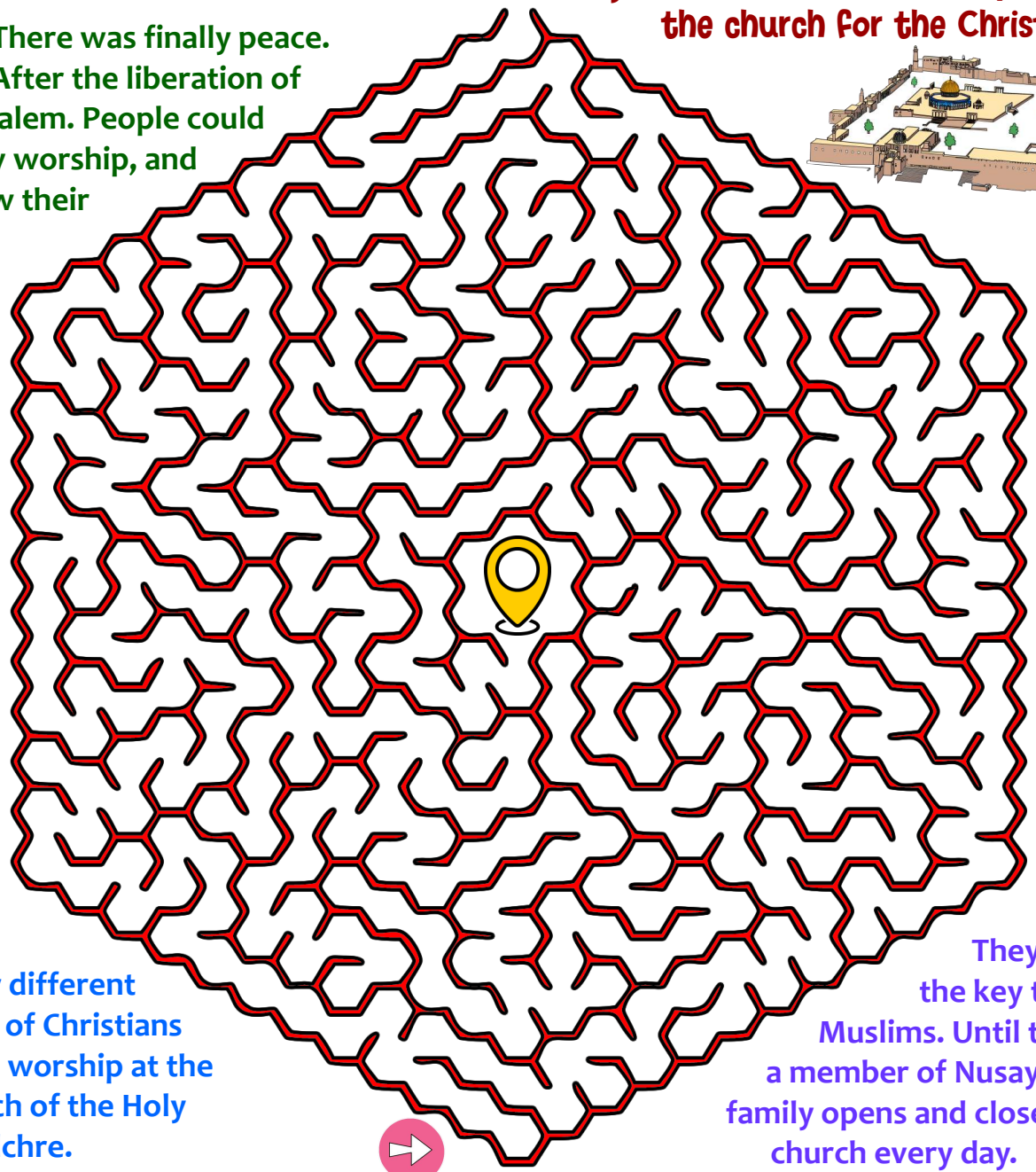
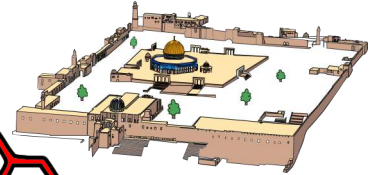

They gave the key to the Muslims. Until today, a member of Nusaybah's family opens and closes the church every day.

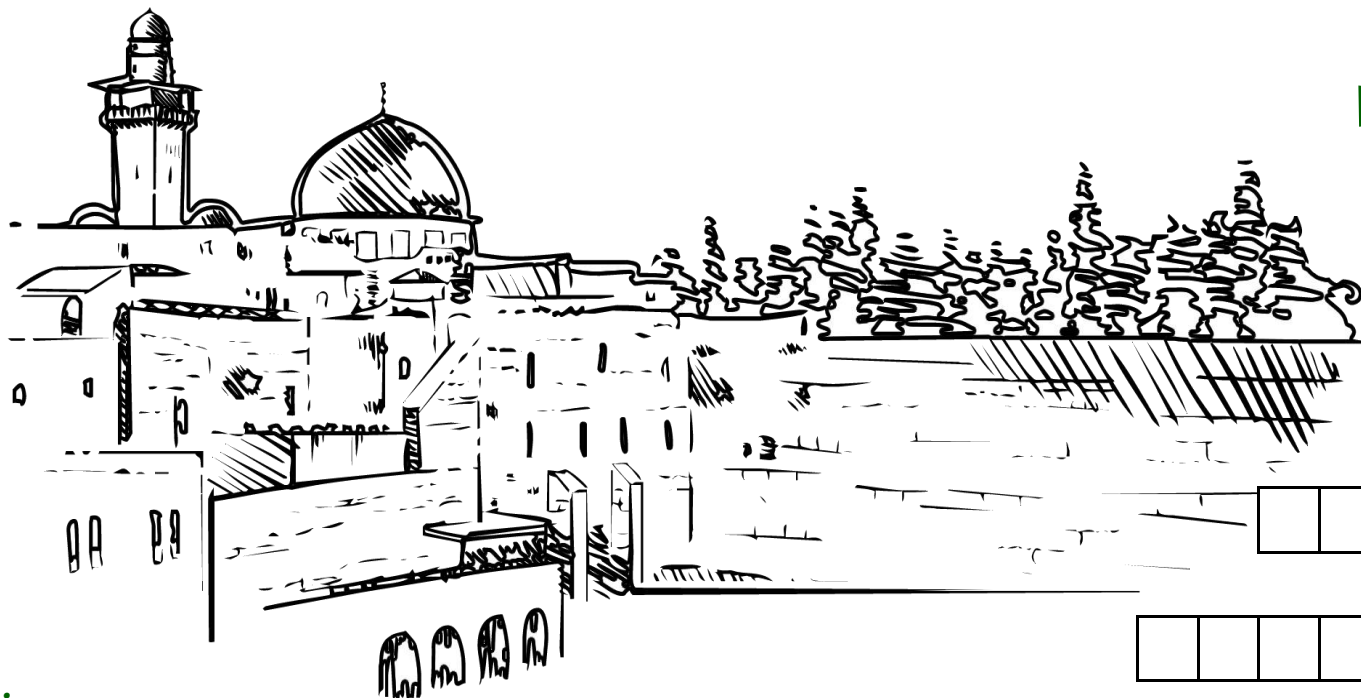
Prophet **Adam** ﷺ built Masjid Al-Aqsa for the first time. It was rebuilt and repaired many times after that.

Prophet **Ibrahim** ﷺ and his second son Prophet **Ishaq** ﷺ, rebuilt Masjid Al-Aqsa.

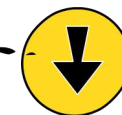

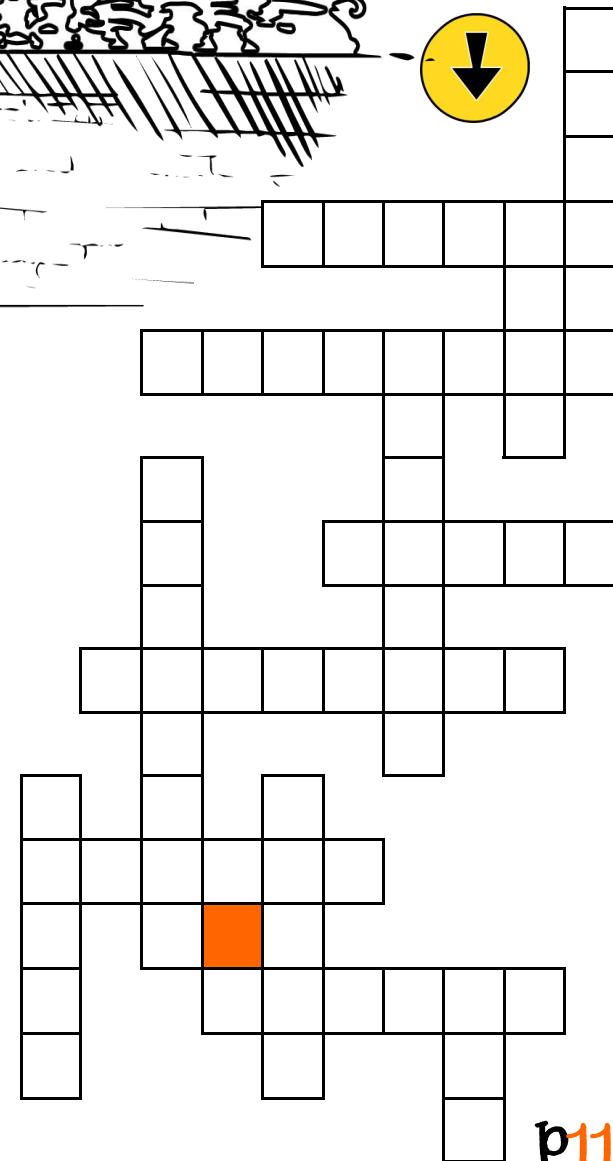

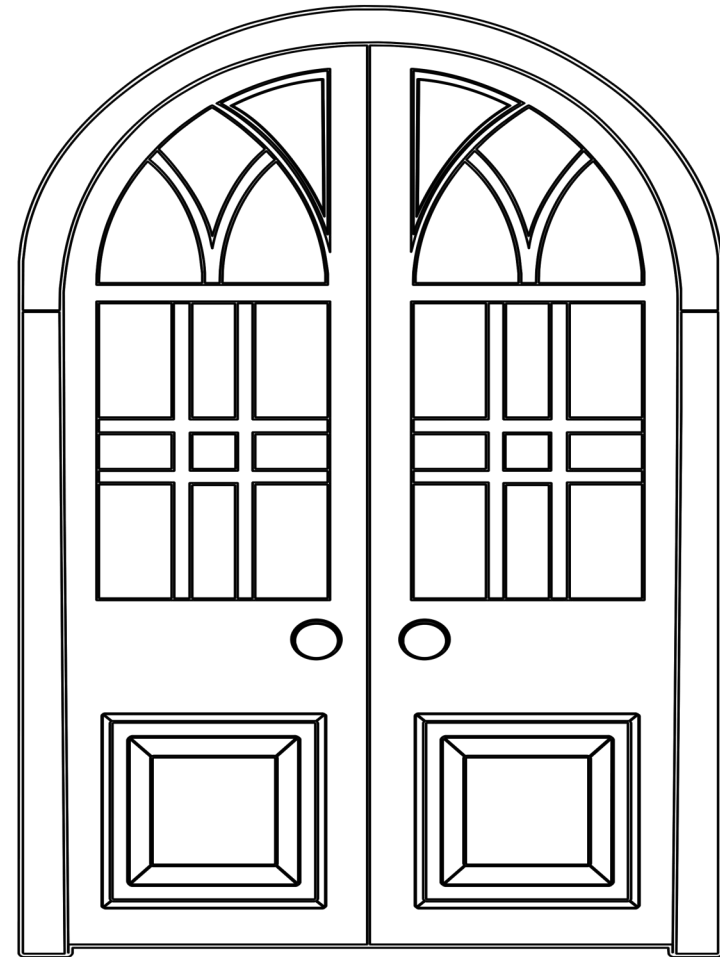
Umar  was known to be fair so the Christians gave him the keys to the church of the Holy Sepulchre.
