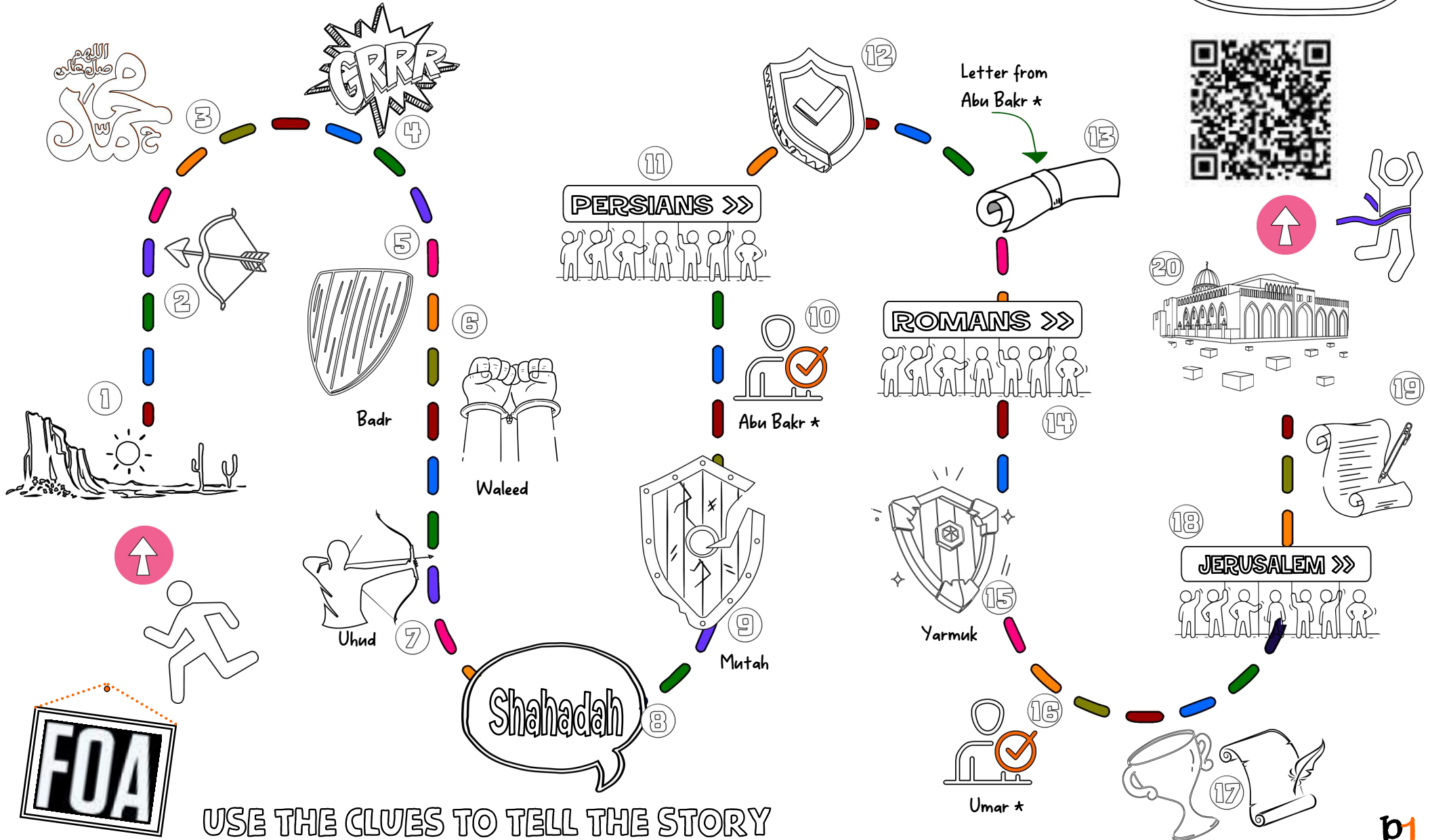

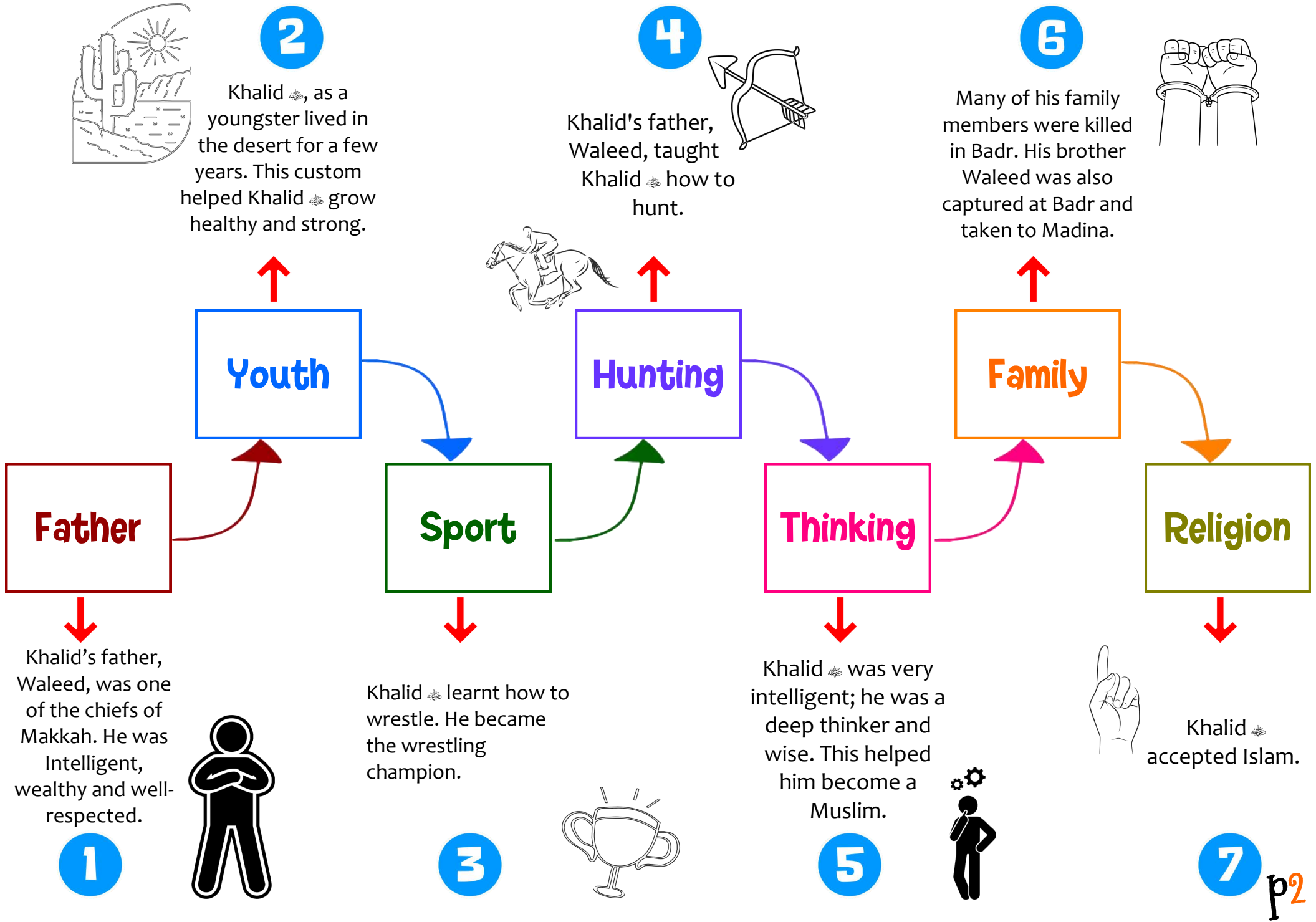

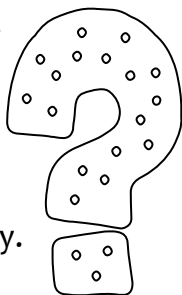

Khalid continued his journey back to Makkah without his brother. The love and respect for Islam also grew in Khalid's heart.

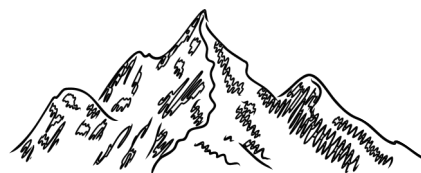
A few months had passed, and the people of Makkah were going to Madina to attack the Muslims. They wanted Khalid to lead the horsemen.

When they arrived in Madina, the Muslim army was waiting for them at mount Uhud.



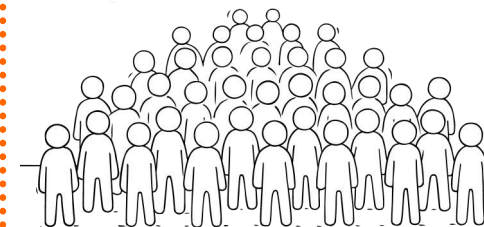
When the battle started, the Muslims fought with courage and bravery. When Khalid saw this, he realised that the back of the Muslim army was exposed.

Khalid attacked, but a group of archers on a hill defended the army. Khalid could not get past them, so he waited.



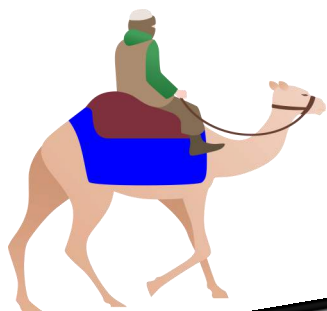
The Muslims seemed to be winning so some Muslim archers left the hill. Seeing the

Muslims move, Khalid attacked the few archers that were left and then attacked the Muslims.

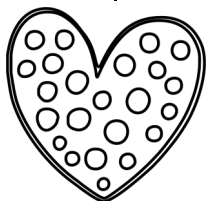
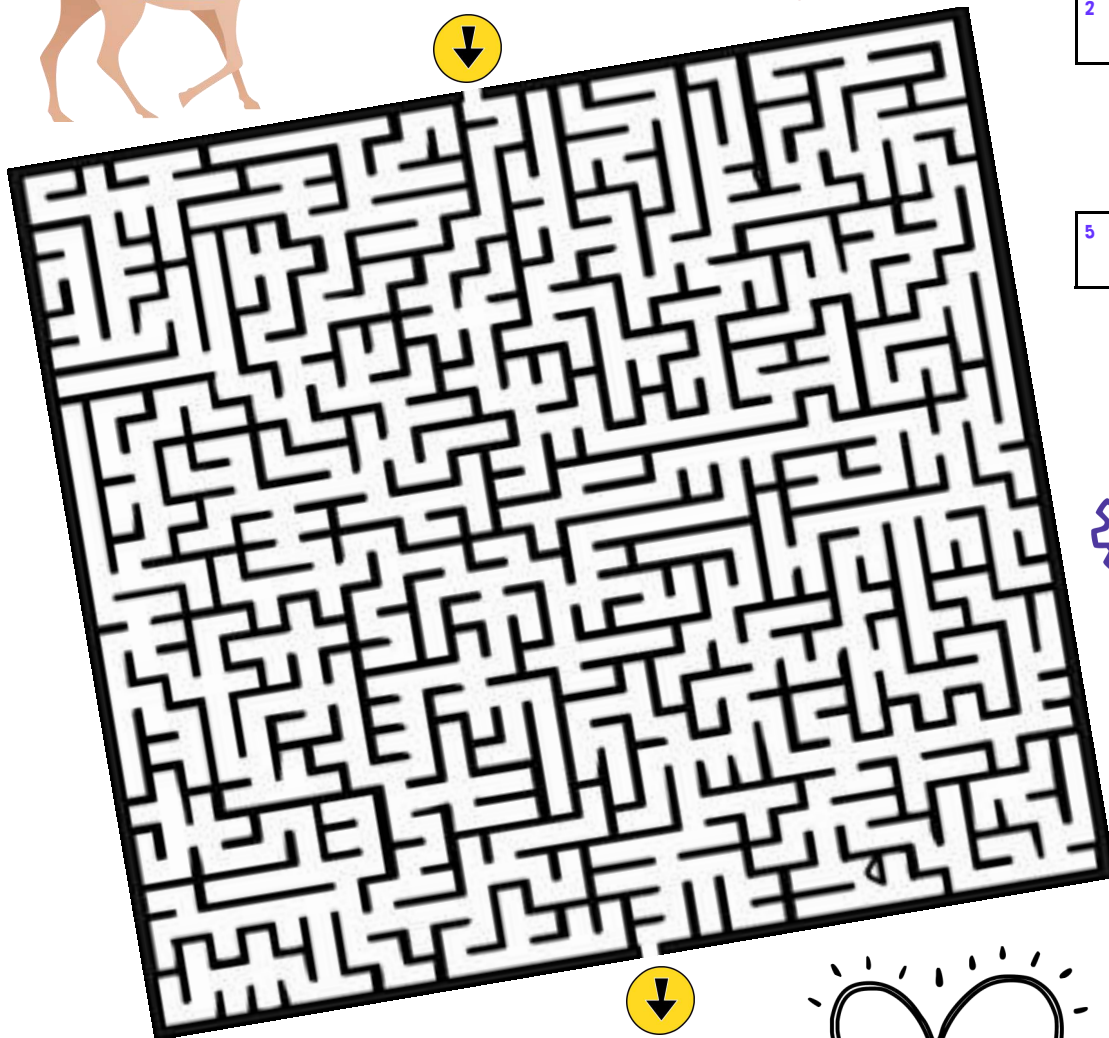


Soon, the Muslim army was retreating. After this the Muslim army started regrouping to attack the Makkans. The Muslims fought bravely and defended themselves.

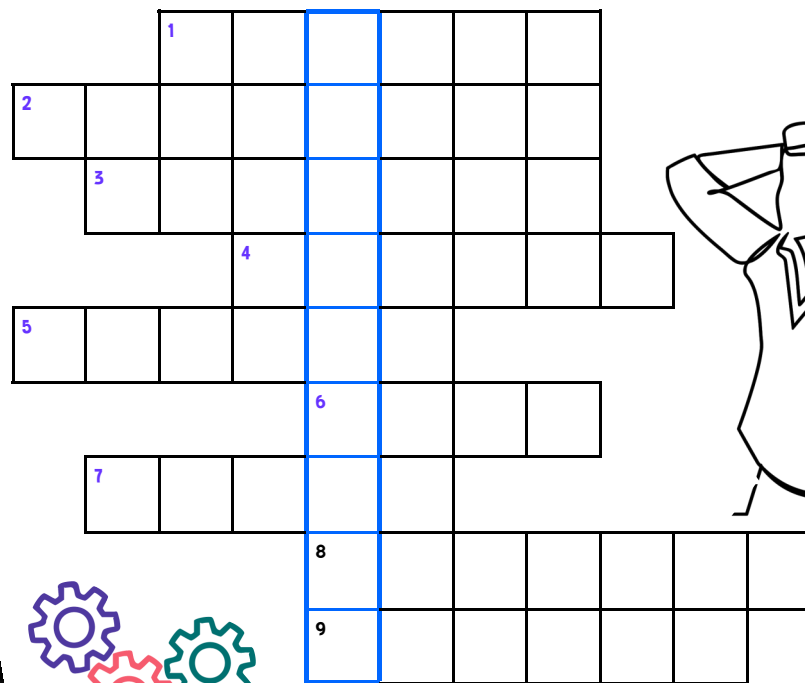

When a person accepts Islam, all their past sins are forgiven. They have a chance of being a good practising Muslim and helping others.

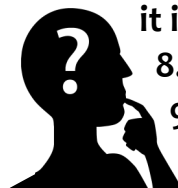

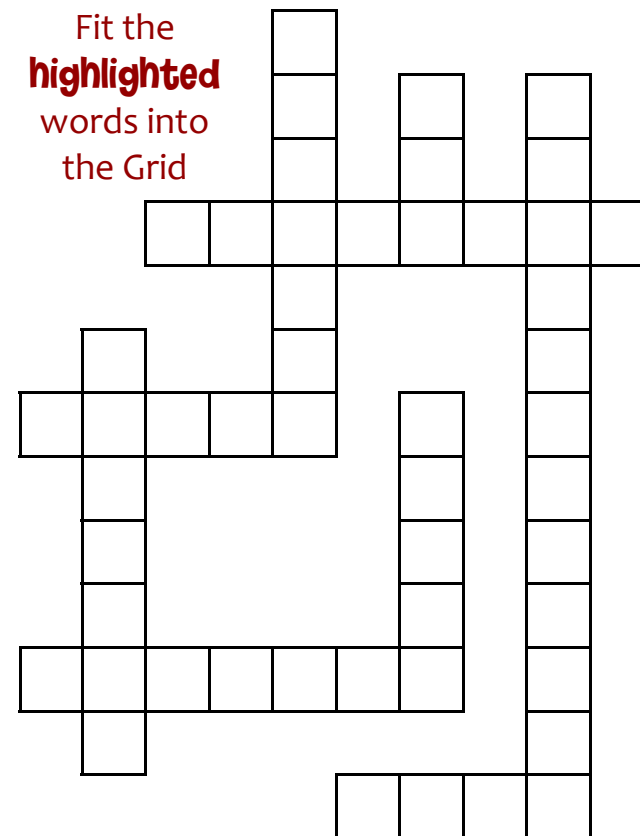

2. Golden Dome

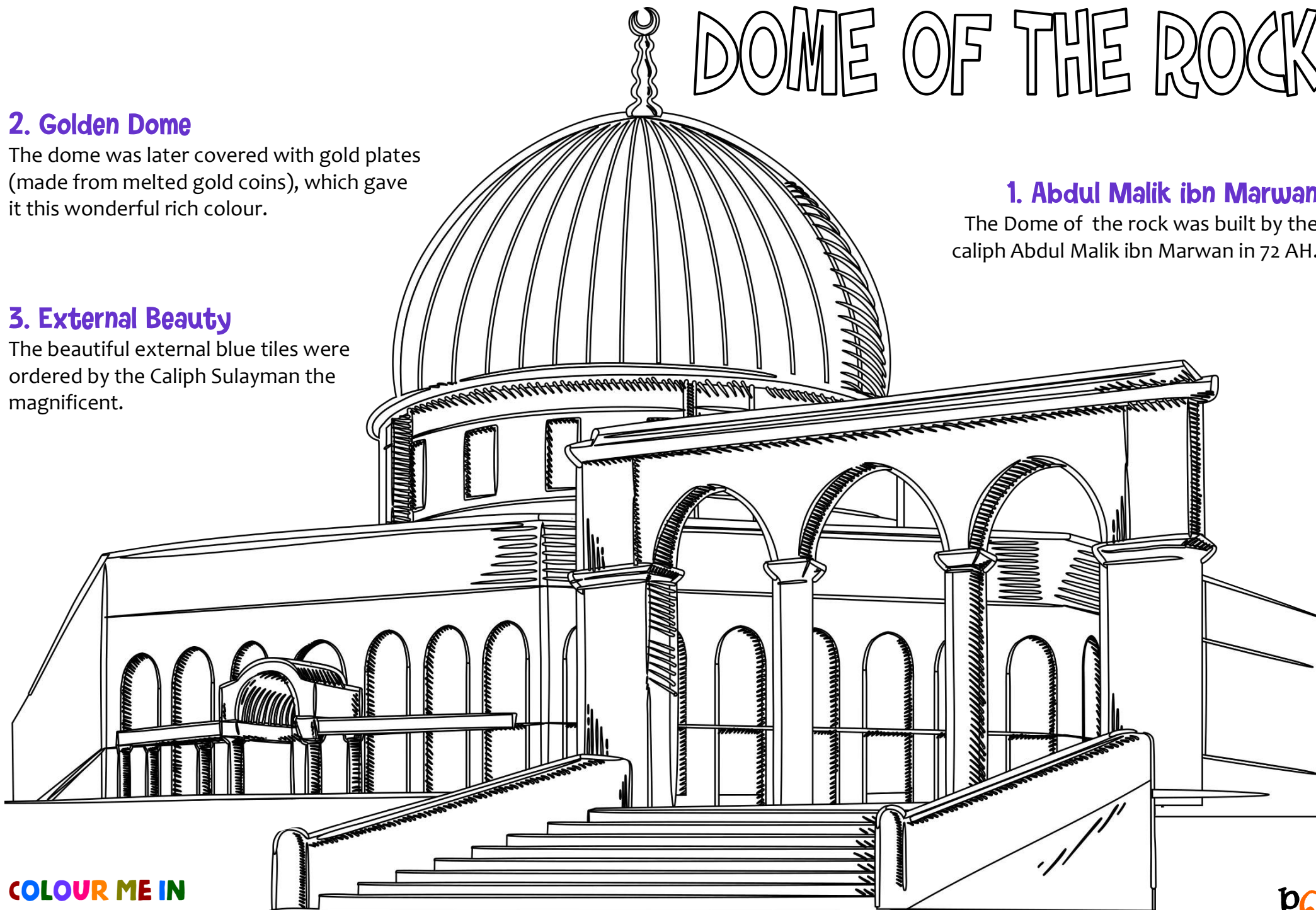
The dome was later covered with gold plates (made from melted gold coins), which gave it this wonderful rich colour.

Khalid ibn Waleed



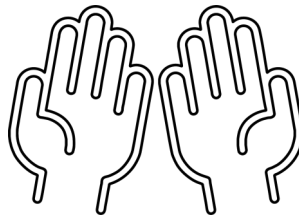

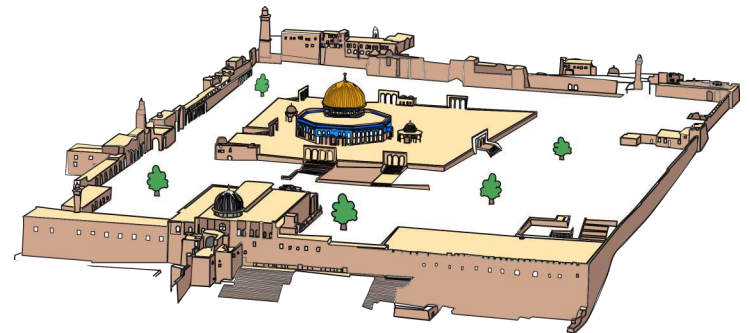
5. Umar ﷺ wrote a treaty which guaranteed safety of all the people and protection of all the different places of worship.



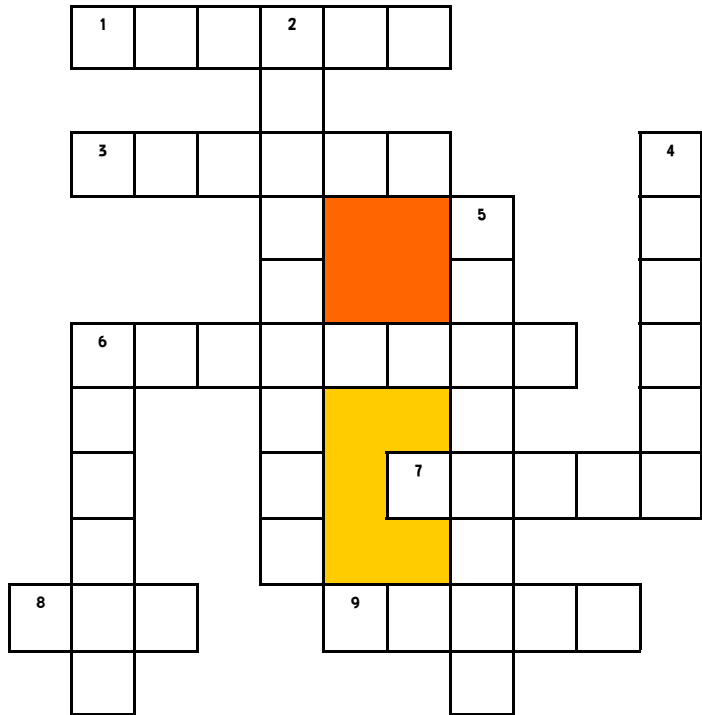
6. Khalid ﷺ also signed the peace treaty.



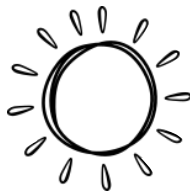
7. Khalid ﷺ and the other Muslims helped Umar ﷺ clear the rubbish from Masjid Al-Aqsa and prayed Salah there.



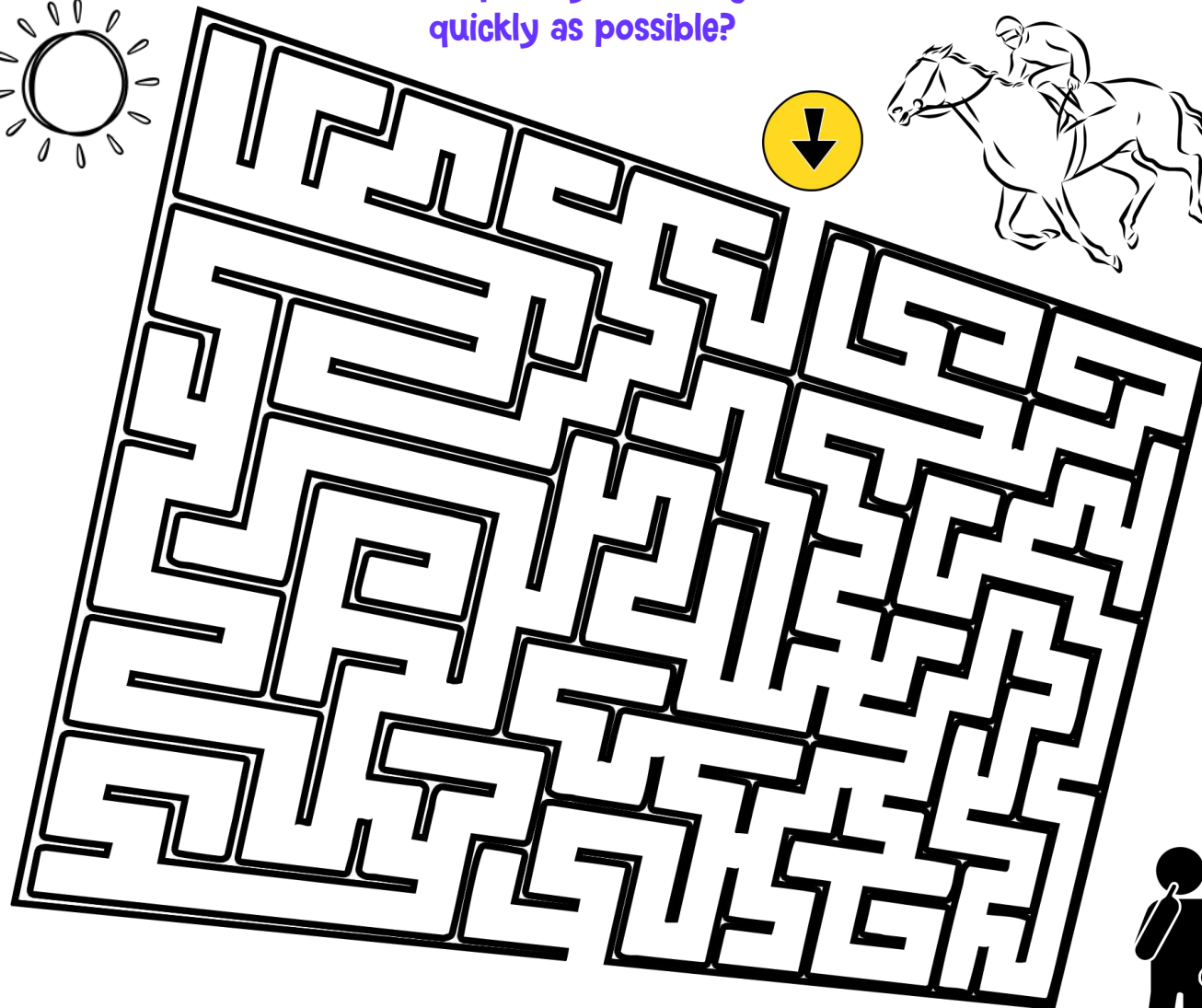
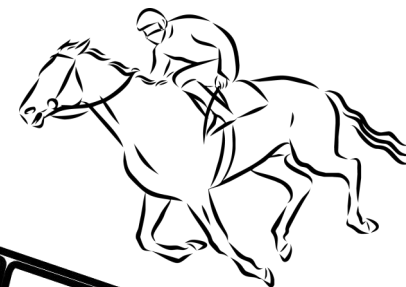

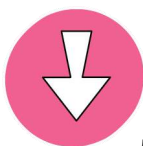

Khalid ؓ trusted Allah and took his army through the hot desert. They managed to get through to the Muslims before the Romans could attack.



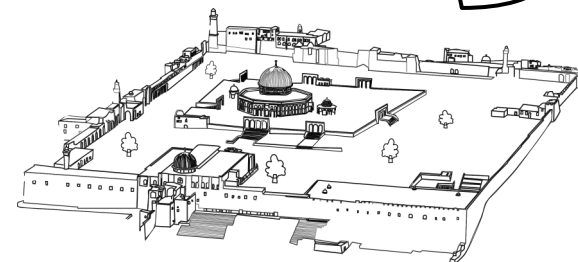

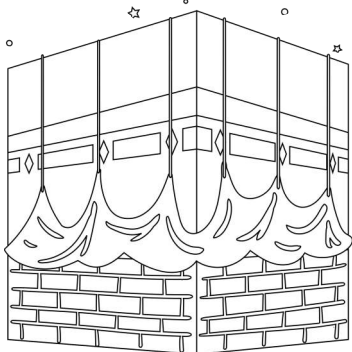
4. After praying Salah at Masjid Al-Aqsa our Prophet ﷺ continued his journey to the heavens.

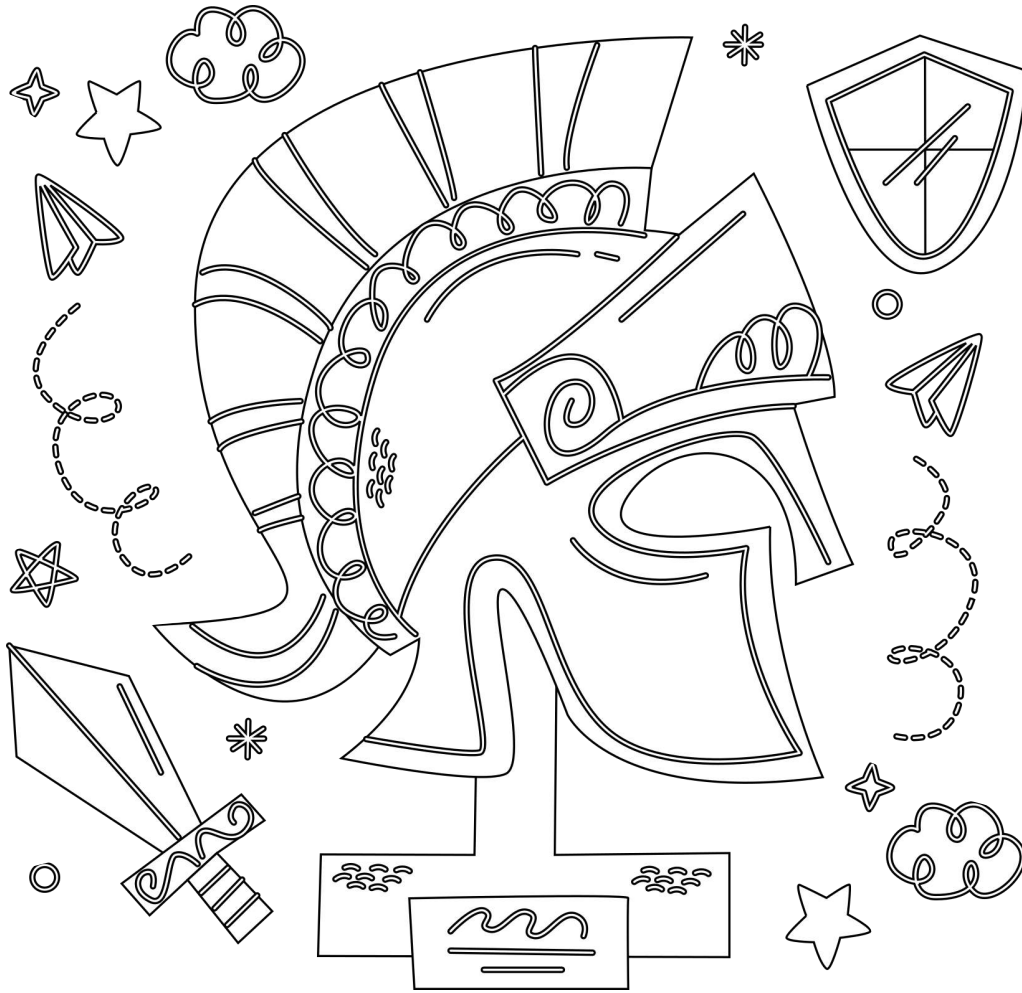

He defeated the **Persians** by applying his skills and **strategy**.

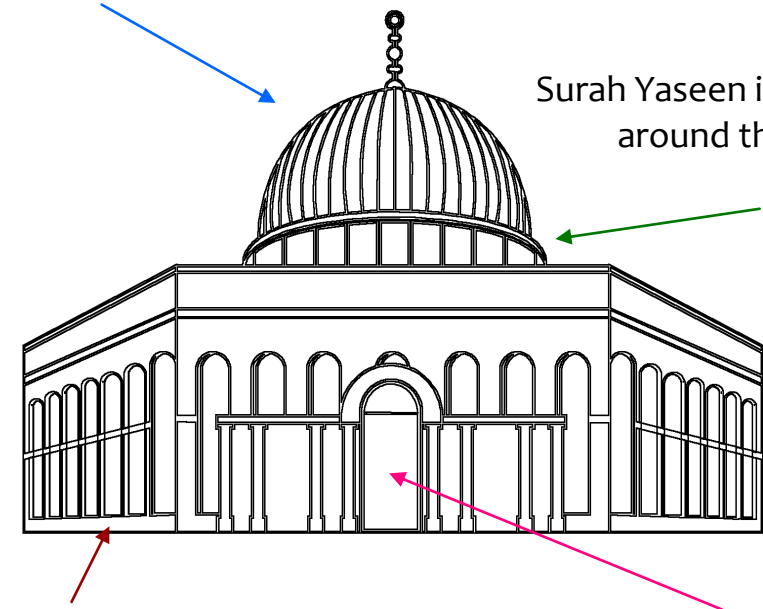
After defeated the **Romans** they came to **Jerusalem**.

It has a beautiful golden Dome which is 25m tall.

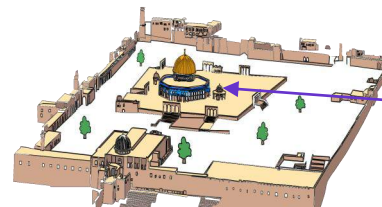
5 FACTS
