Umar ؓ was looking after the camels in the desert.

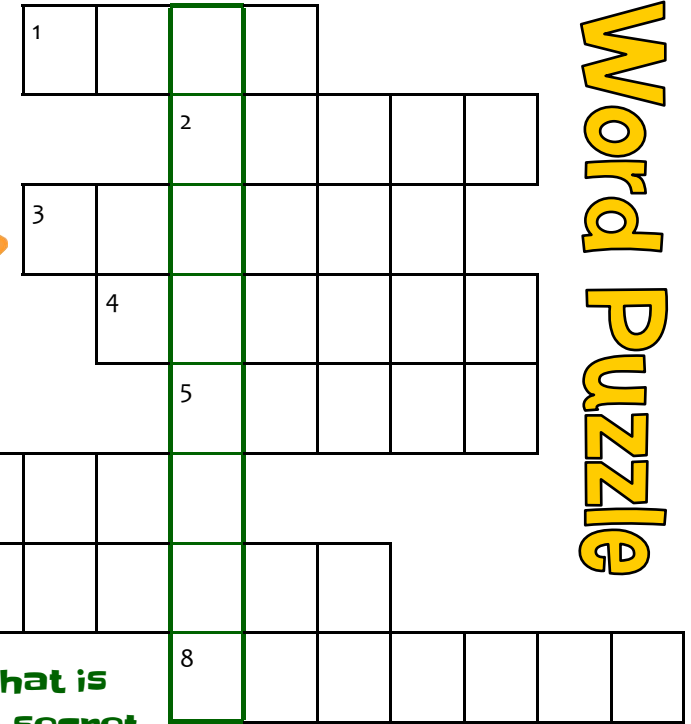

Umar رضي الله عنه was angry as he walked down the street with a sword in his hand. He was actually furious. Anyone who saw him knew that someone was in big trouble!



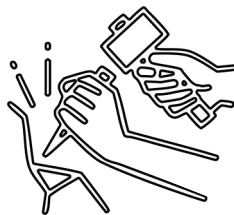
Umar رضي الله عنه had seen how Islam was slowly spreading, and this made him upset. He didn't like change.

He could hear some words being spoken as he banged on the door.



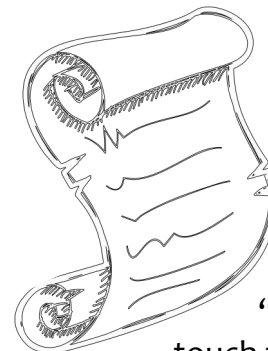
Fatima رضي الله عنها was reading some Qur'an with her husband and one of the sahabah. She hid the pages and quickly opened the door.

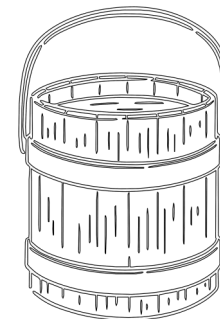
Umar رضي الله عنه asked her again what they had been reading, and she told him that they had been reading verses from the Qur'an.

Umar رضي الله عنه became a Muslim after reading some verses of the Holy Qur'an

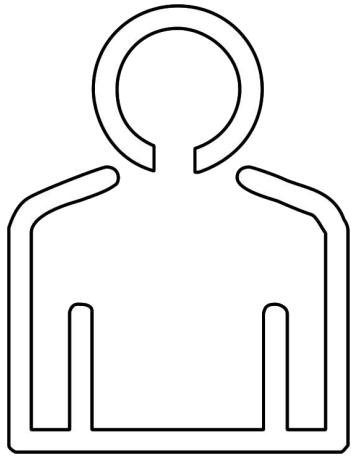

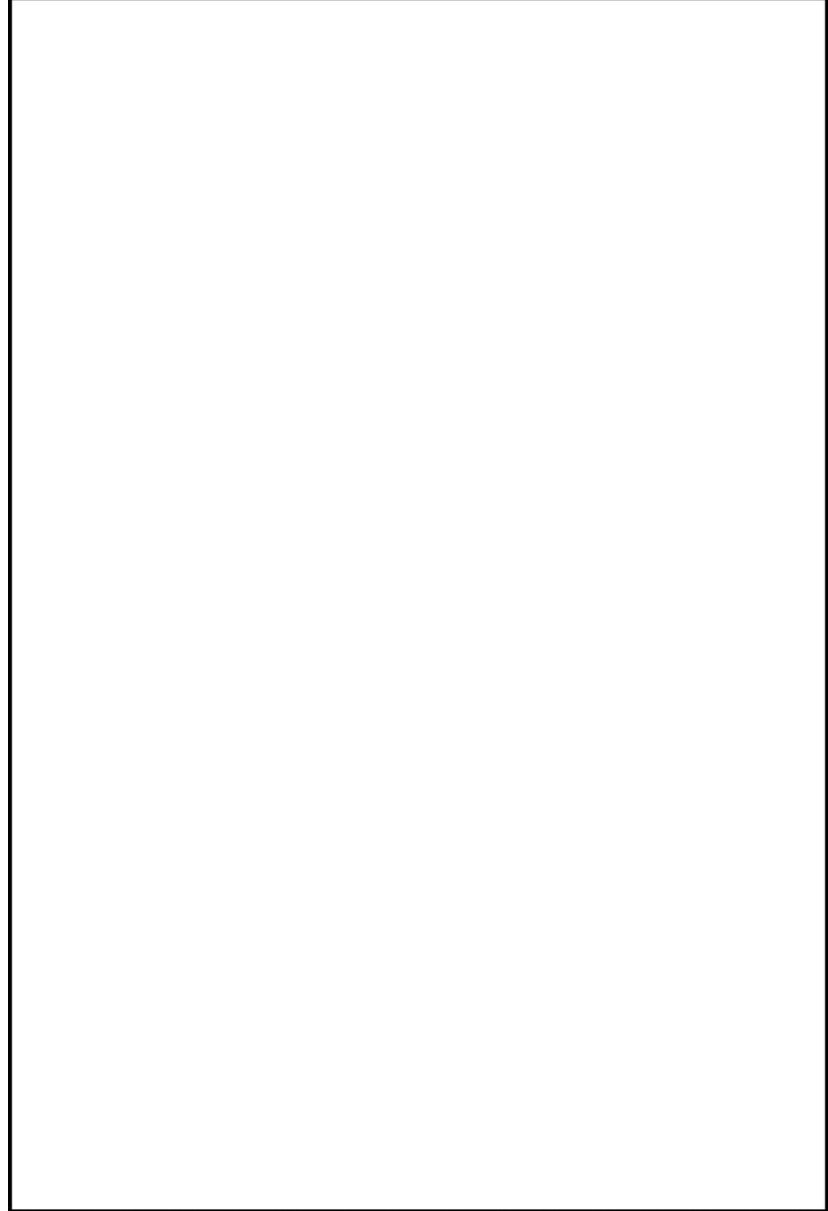
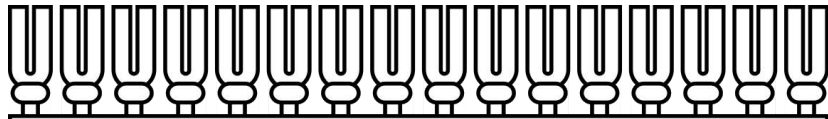


4. Prayed Salah

THE KA'BAH

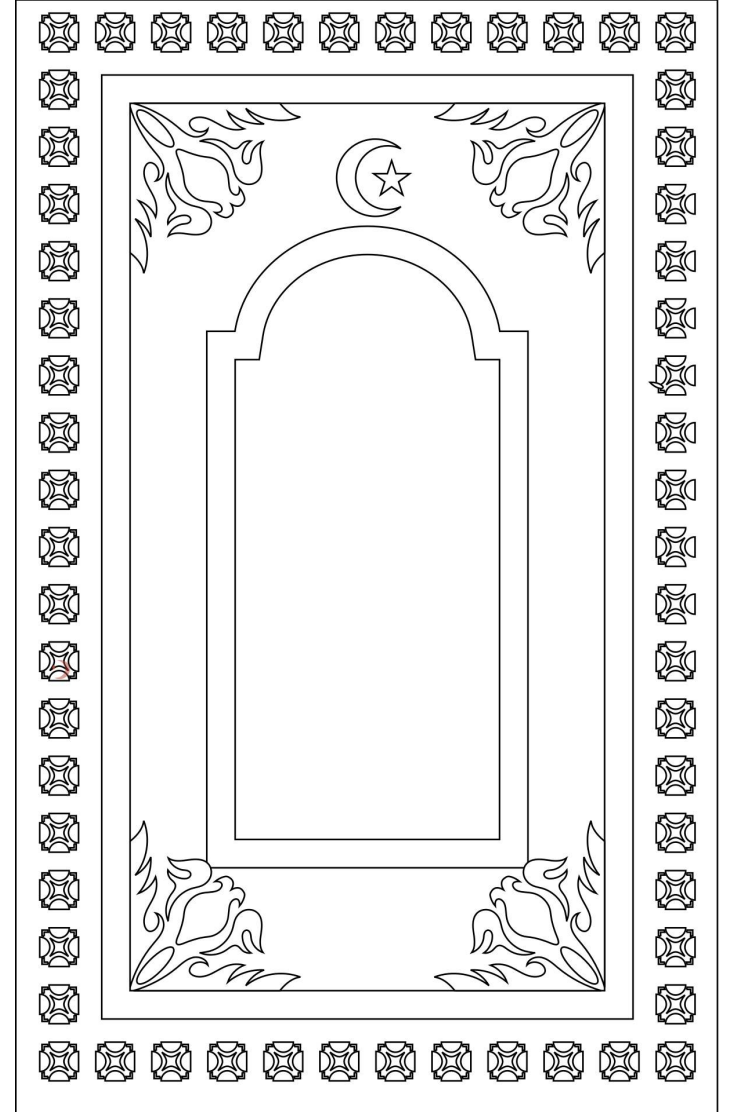
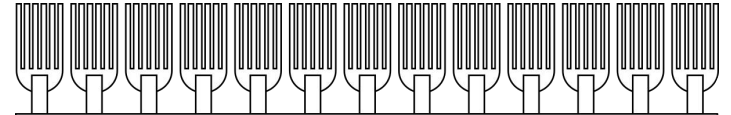
In Madina, Allah commanded the Muslims to pray in the direction of the Ka'bah. It became the new Qibla.

When the Muslim empire became vast and extremely wealthy, Umar ﷺ continued to lead a simple life and eat simple food.

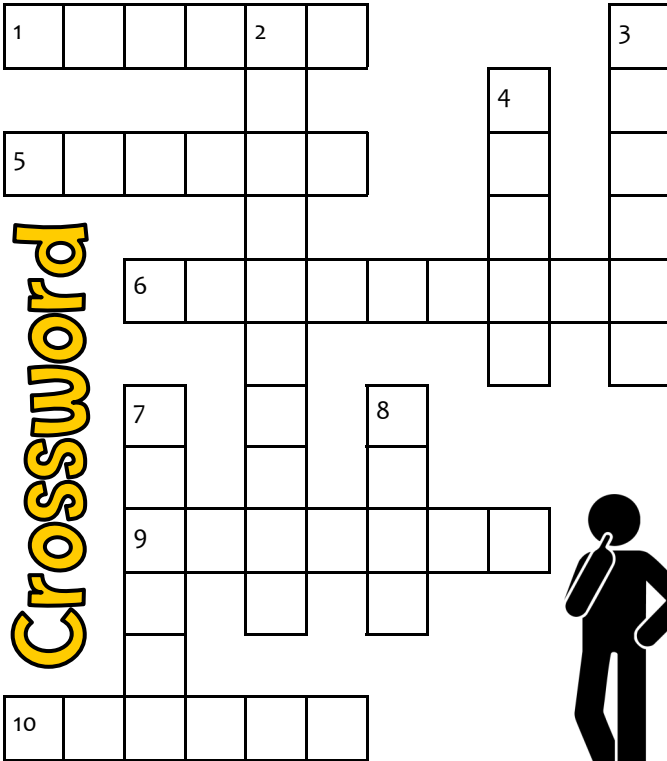
He wanted to behave exactly like Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and follow his example.



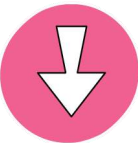

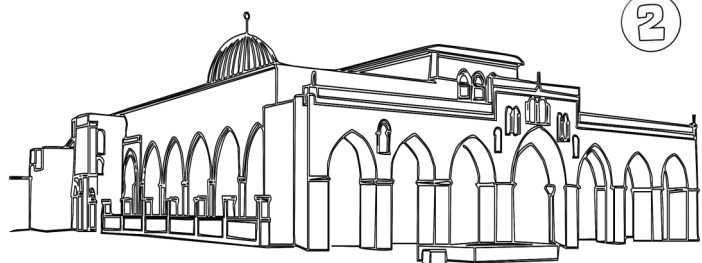
The Dome of the Rock (Qubbat As-Sakhra), the centrepiece of Masjid Al-Aqsa.

Masjid Al-Aqsa

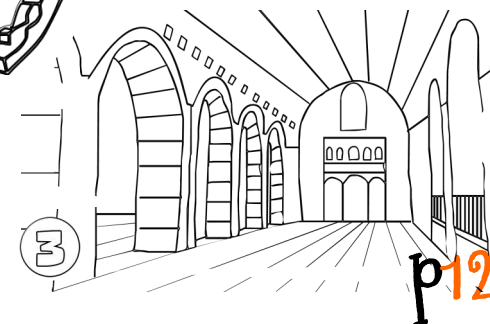

All the musallas, mihrabs, educational platforms, trees, fountains, wells, open areas, and so forth are part of Masjid al-Aqsa



Musalla Marwani is an underground area originally built to support the structure of Musalla Qibly



This Musalla Al-Qibly is situated at the front of Masjid al-Aqsa by the southern wall.
