We should always respect and care for the "houses" of Allah.


Allah created two very special places on Earth through Prophet


Ibrahim left Hajar and Ismail some water and dates. Soon the water and food finished and baby Ismail started crying.

When she returned, Allah agave them His help. A spring of water miraculously gushed out of the sand near baby Ismail. This water is called Zamzam.





Famine


A long famine was coming so Yusuf stockpiled all

the extra grain in the good years and helped save the people in the famine years.




Many years later, during the famine, Yusuf's brothers came to Egypt for food.

The famine also effected the people in Jerusalem. The brothers of Yusuf went to Egypt to get food for their families.


It was here, that Yusuf recognised his brothers and eventually invited them all to come and live with him in Egypt.



His father, Prophet Yaqub , was now an old man and tears of joy flowed from his eyes when he finally met his son Yusuf Will.


