## Iblis

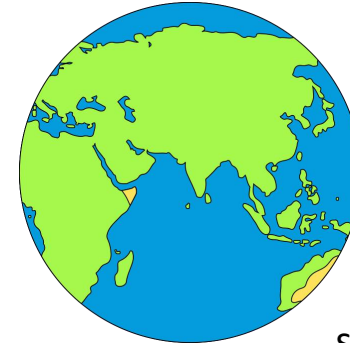

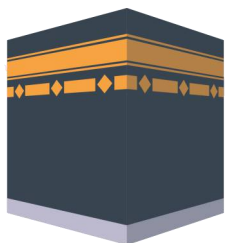
## The Tree

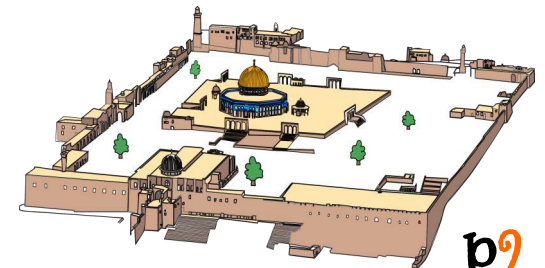


## Earth

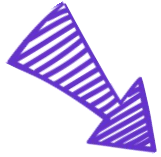

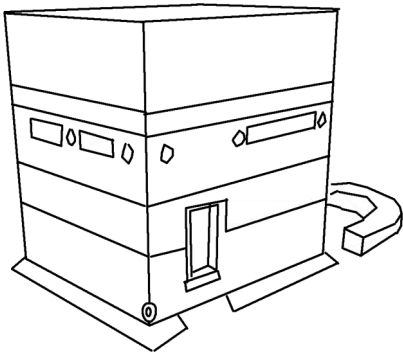

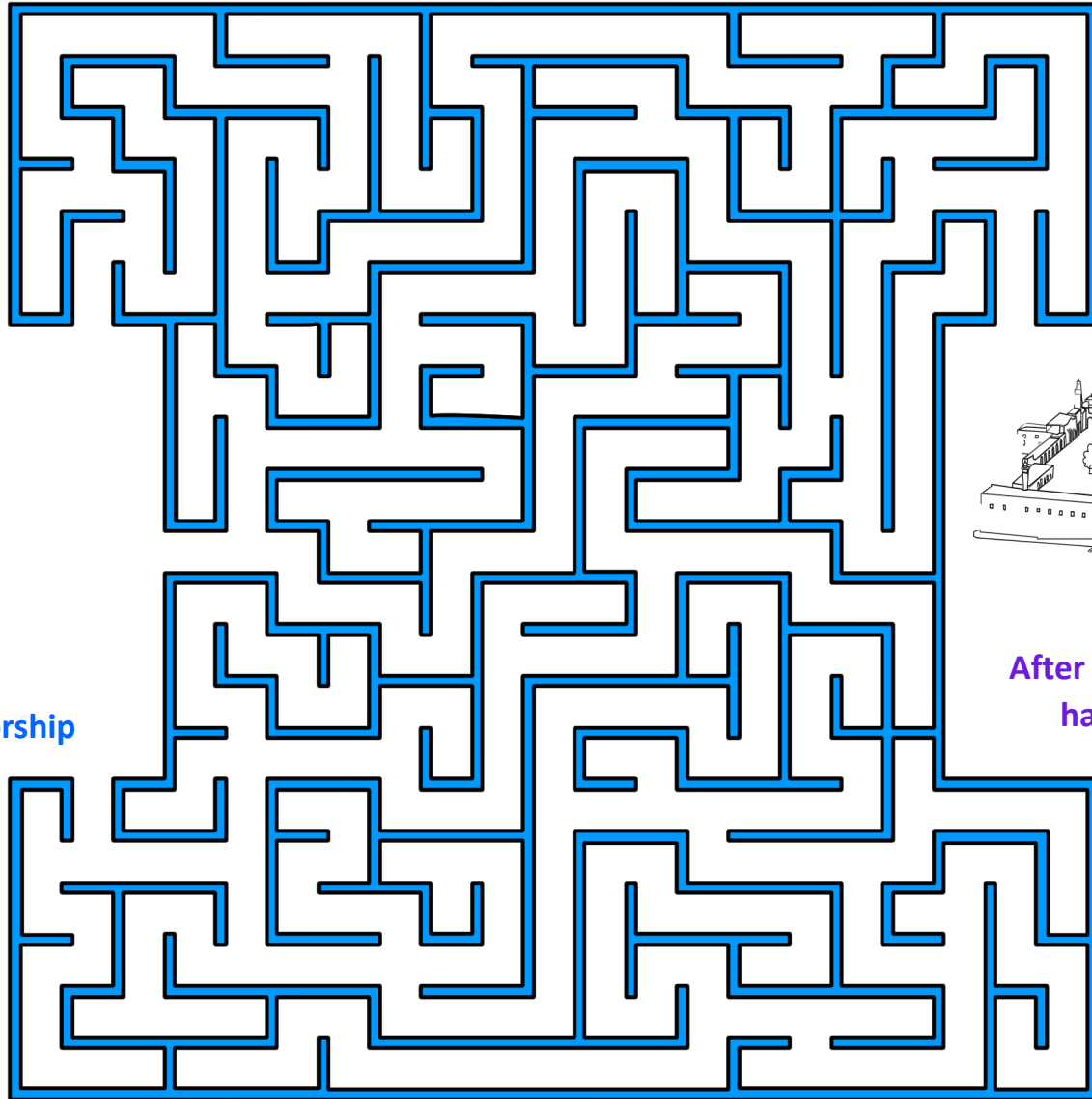


## The Ka'bah

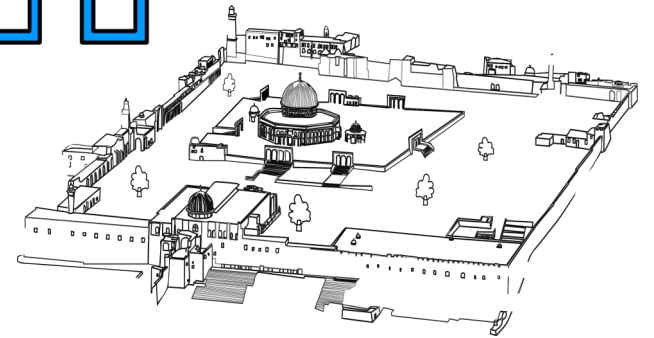


This was the first place of worship built by Prophet Adam عليه السلام.

Adam عليه السلام built the Ka'bah in Makkah. The Ka'bah is a sacred and blessed place. Even today it remains the most important place on Earth.



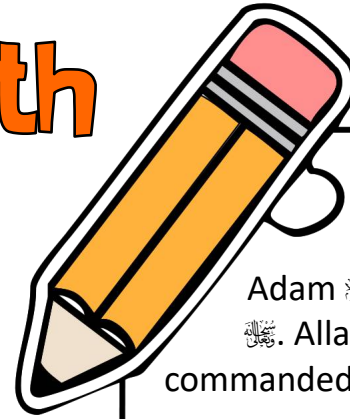
## Masjid Al-Aqsa



After building the Ka'bah, forty years had passed. Allah ﷻ commanded Prophet Adam عليه السلام to go to Jerusalem and build a special place of worship (Masjid Al-Aqsa).

Even today, Masjid Al-Aqsa remains a sacred and holy place.

# From Jannah to Earth



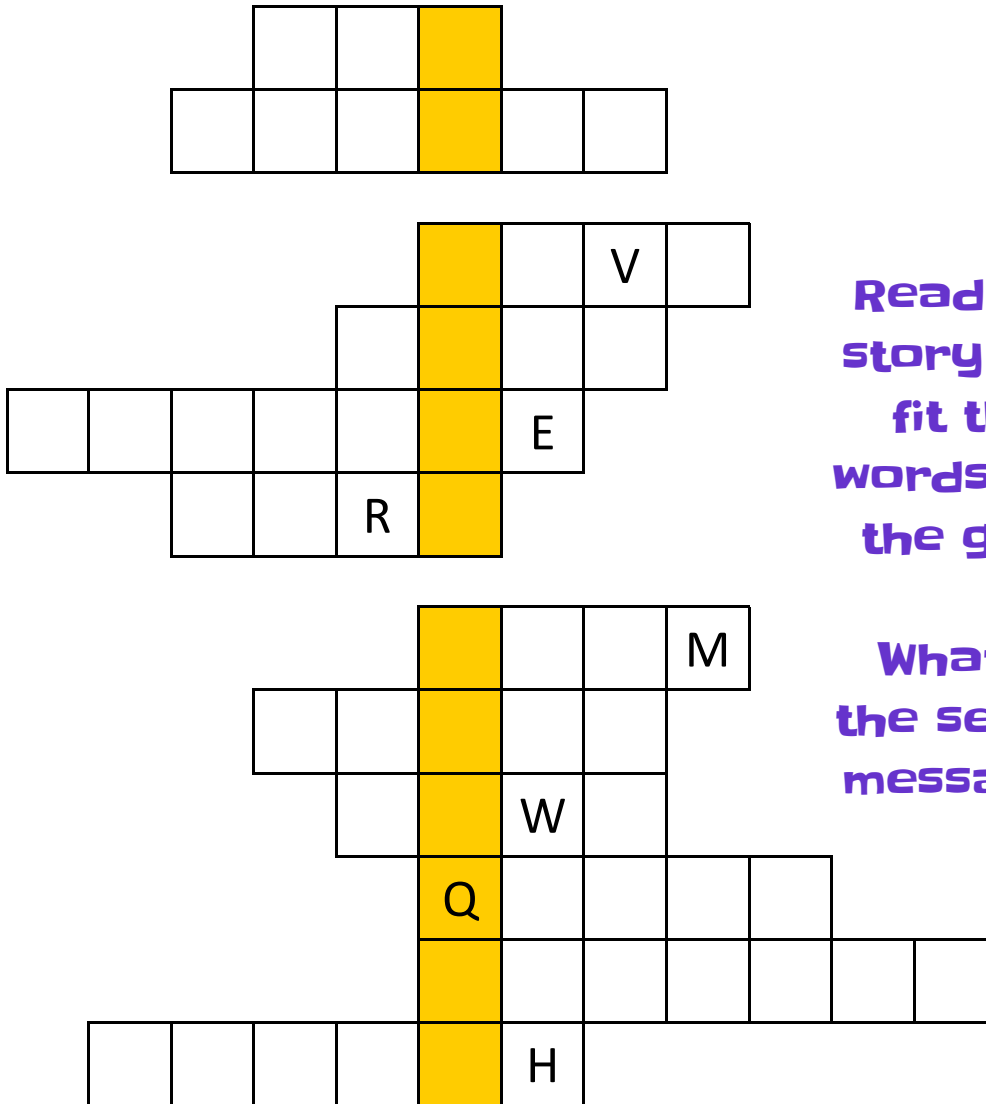
Adam ﷺ was the first man created by Allah ﷻ. Allah ﷻ made him out of **soil**. Allah ﷻ commanded the **Angels** to bow to Adam.

**Iblis** was a Jinn and was made from **fire**. He lived with the Angels who were made from light (Nur). Iblis did not **bow** down because he thought he was better than Adam ﷺ. He was very Jealous because Allah ﷻ honoured Adam ﷺ. So Iblis disobeyed Allah ﷻ and is now known as **Shaytan**.

**Adam** ﷺ lived in Jannah with his wife **Hawa**. They were very happy in Jannah. Allah ﷻ told Adam and Hawa ﷻ that they can enjoy everything in **Jannah**. However, they could not eat from one tree.

Shaytan tricked Adam and Hawa into eating from the forbidden tree. Allah sent them away from Jannah to **live** on Earth. They were very sorry and Allah ﷻ **forgave** them.

We learn about the story of Adam ﷺ in the Holy **Qur'an**. It reminds us that Allah ﷻ is the Most Merciful so we should also ask Allah ﷻ to forgive our mistakes.

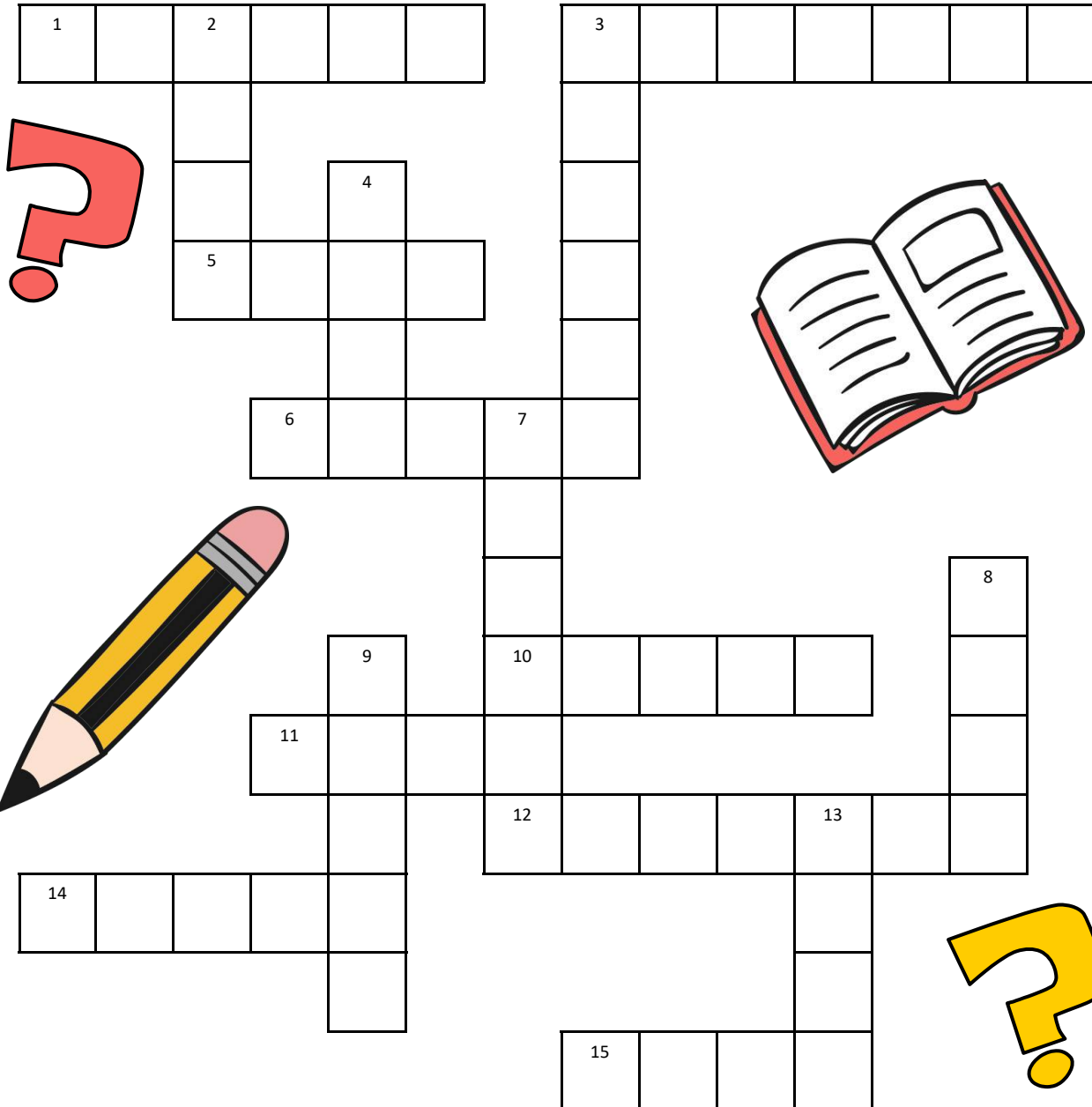

# MASJID Al-Aqsa

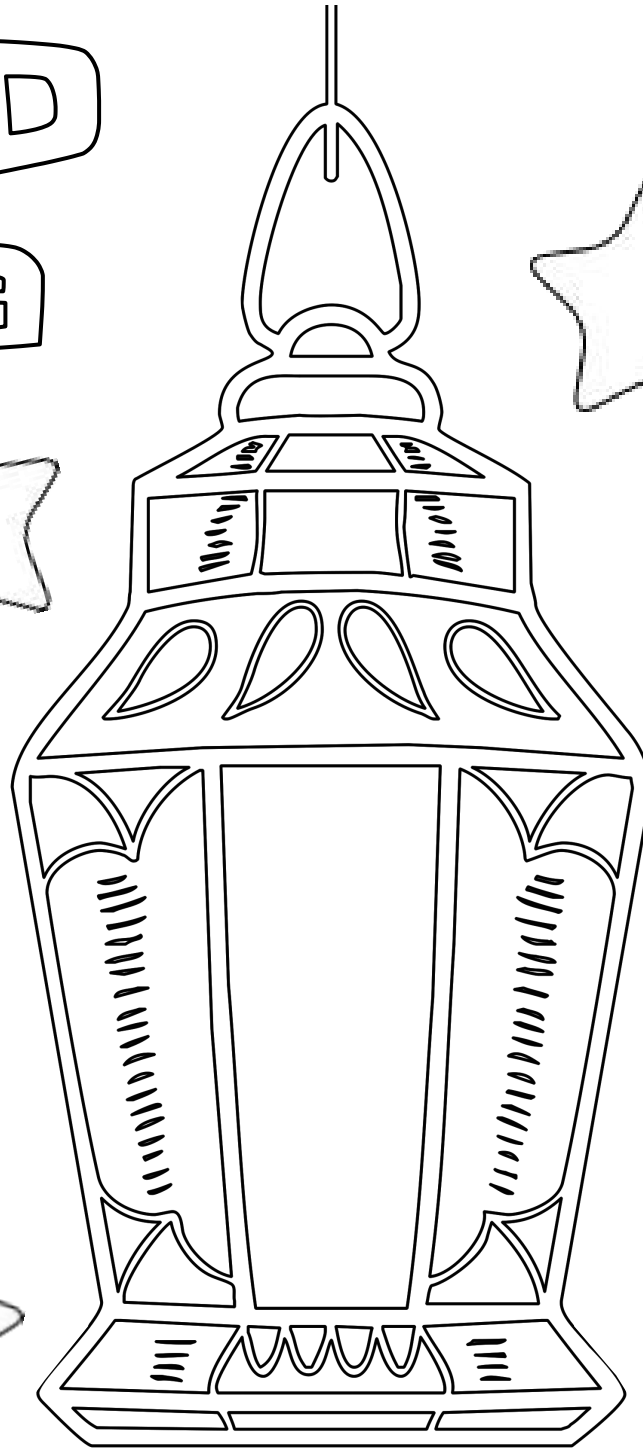
The Prophet ﷺ was asked,

The importance of Masjid Al-Aqsa and visiting it is highlighted by our beloved Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

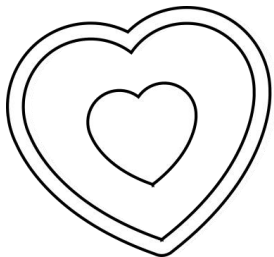
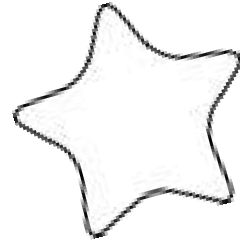
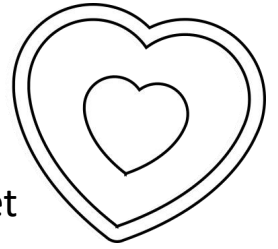
If you can't travel to Masjid al-Aqsa, then send a gift for the Masjid. This will be very rewarding.

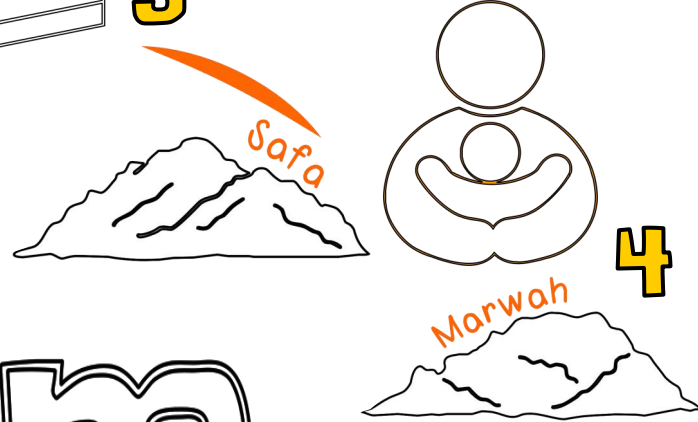
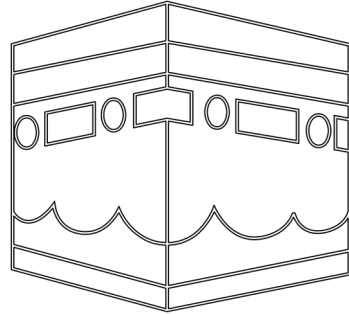
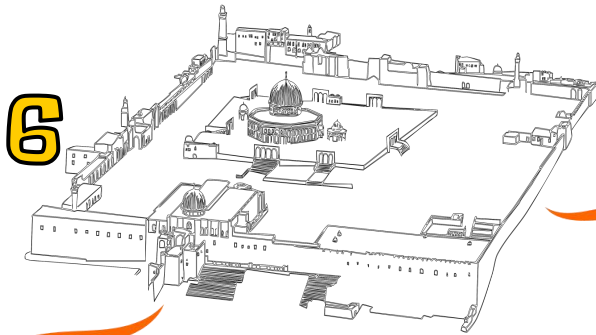
## Special Connection

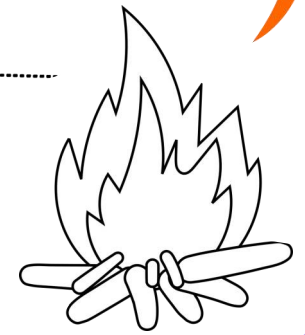
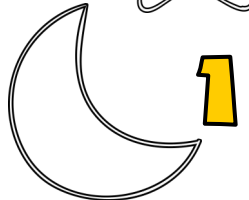
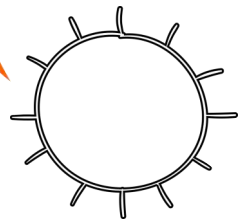

# The Story of Ibrahim عليه السلام ...

Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام was a great prophet of Allah سبحانه وتعالى. He was given the title Khalil (friend) of Allah سبحانه وتعالى. He worshipped and dedicated his life to Allah سبحانه وتعالى.

## Idol Worship



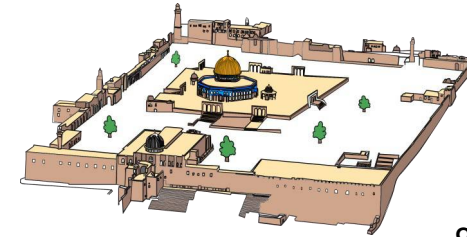
When Ibrahim عليه السلام was a youngster he saw people making idols. The people would worship the same idols that they made themselves. Even at a young age, Ibrahim عليه السلام knew this was wrong.



## Zamzam

Ibrahim عليه السلام was commanded to leave baby Ismail and Hajar عليها السلام in an empty desert. When their water ran out, Allah سبحانه وتعالى provided Zamzam water for them.

## Tawheed



Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام obeyed Allah سبحانه وتعالى and had great faith in Allah سبحانه وتعالى. Allah سبحانه وتعالى told Ibrahim عليه السلام to rebuild the Ka'bah and Masjid Al-Aqsa.



Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام had two sons, Ismail عليه السلام and Ishaq عليه السلام. Our beloved Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم was from the descendants of Prophet Ismail عليه السلام. Many great prophets including Yusuf, Musa, Isa, Dawud, Yahya عليه السلام were from Prophet Ishaq عليه السلام.



# ZamZam

Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام was commanded by Allah ﷻ to take his wife Hajar عليها السلام \* and baby son Ismail to an empty desert. He left them between the hills of Safa and Marwah.

Ibrahim عليه السلام left Hajar عليها السلام and Ismail some water and dates. Soon the water and food finished and baby Ismail started crying.

To look for water, Hajar عليها السلام ran up the hill of Safa. She looked in every direction for any sign of water, or any person who could help them. But she saw nothing.

Hajar عليها السلام then ran up the hill of Marwah. Again she searched for help and water. Still there was nothing. Because she was so worried, she ran between Safa and Marwah seven times to look.

When she returned, Allah ﷻ gave them His help. A spring of water miraculously gushed out of the sand near baby Ismail عليه السلام. This water is called Zamzam.

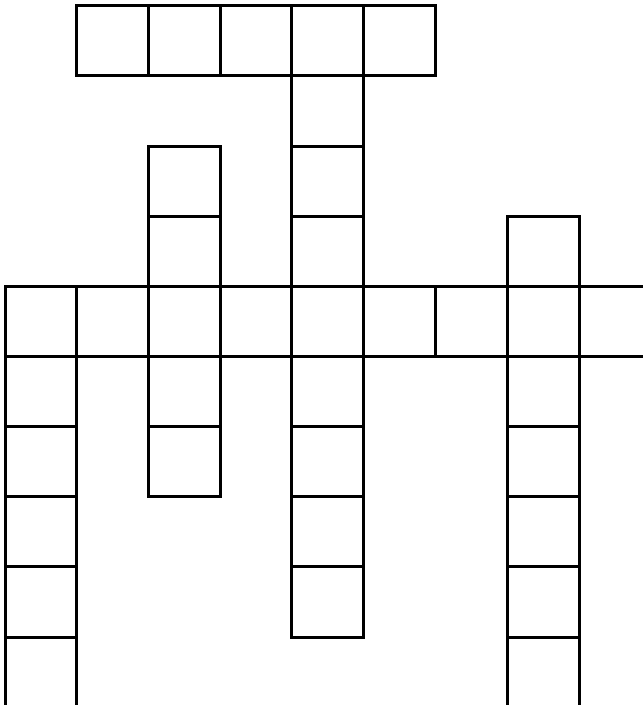

Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام found Masjid Al-Aqsa in ruins so he rebuilt it with his son Ishaq عليه السلام.

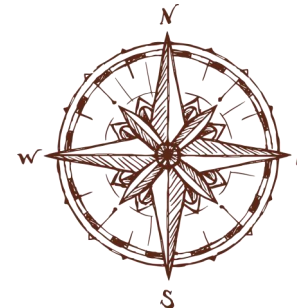


## 4. Ishaq

Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام is known as **Abu Al-Ambiyya** which means the father of the Prophets.

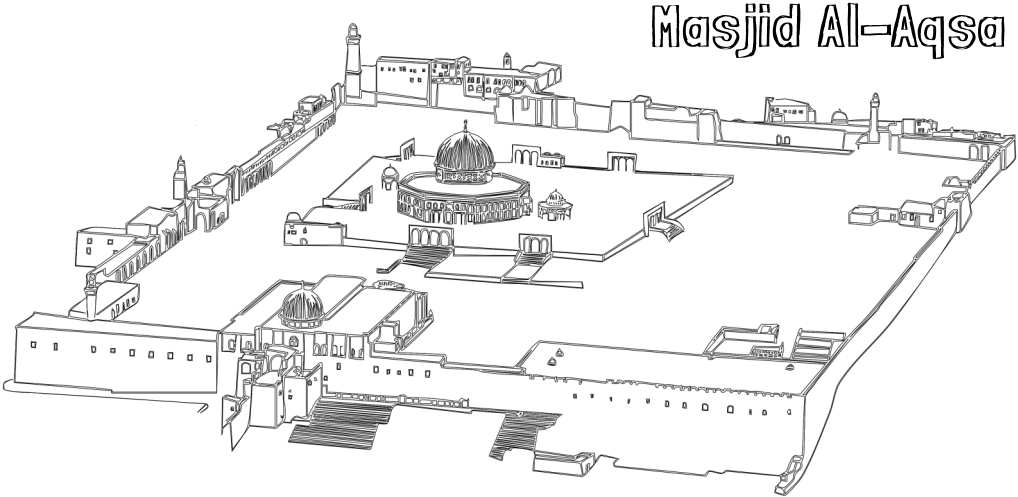
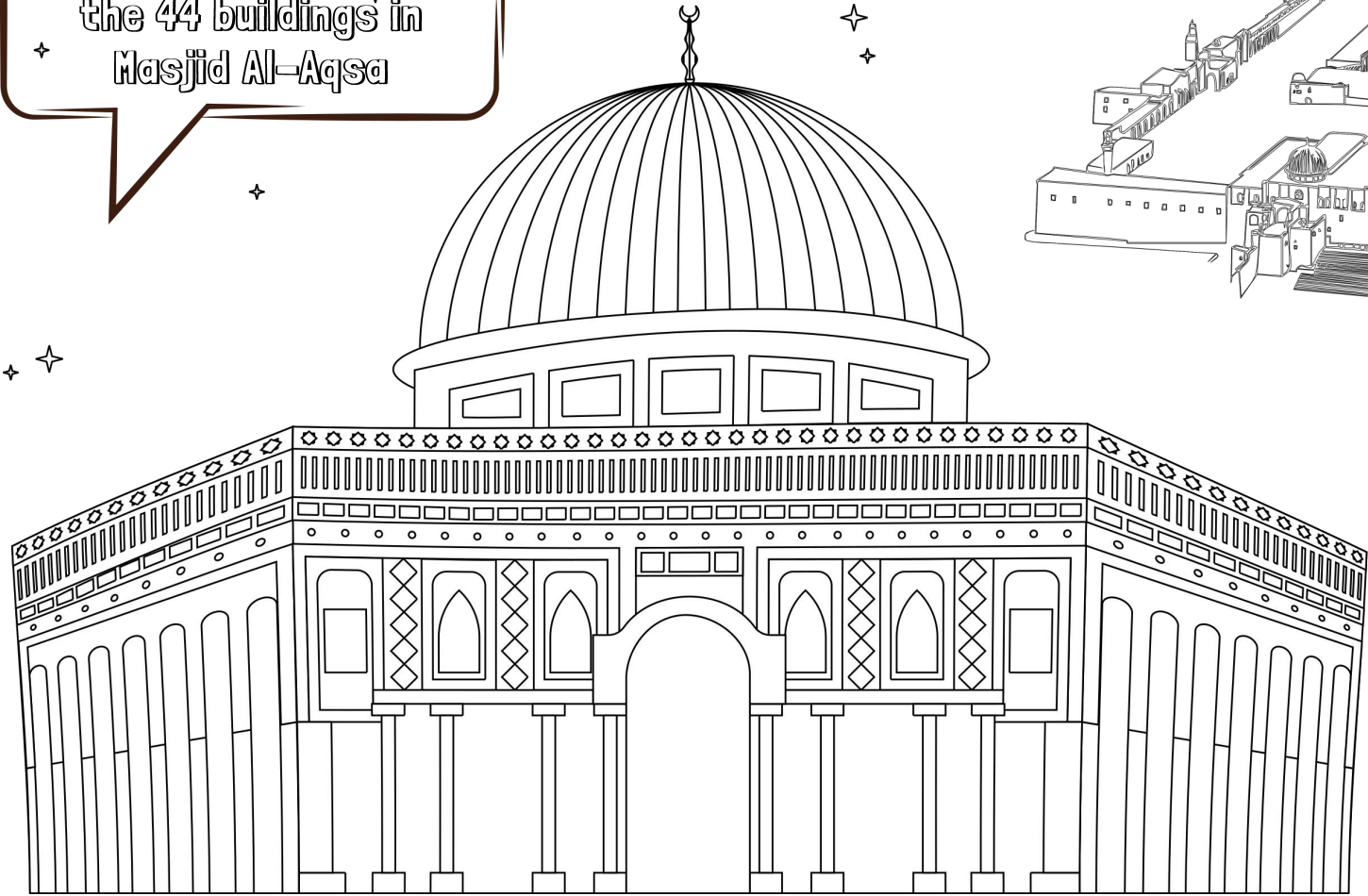

The Prophets also taught their people that Allah ﷻ is One (Tawheed).

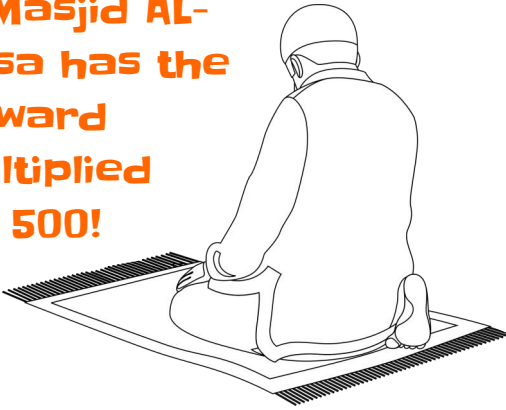


This is 'Dome of the Rock' which is one of the 44 buildings in Masjid Al-Aqsa

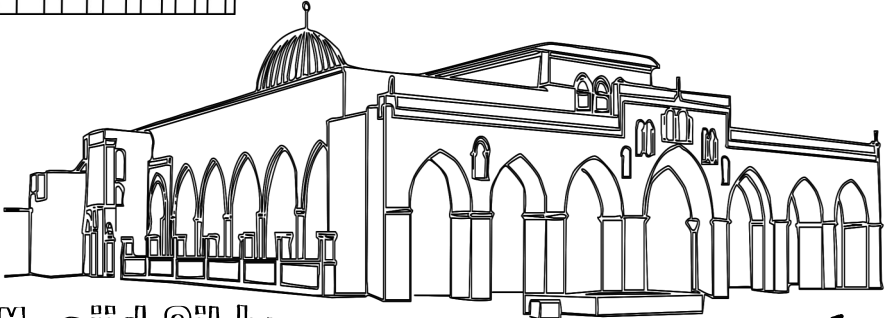


Masjid Al-Aqsa

## Trust in Allah ﷻ

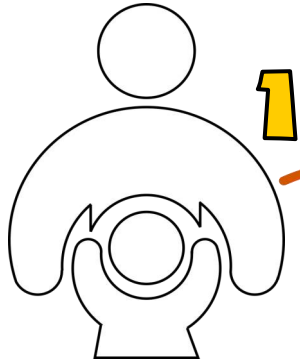

As a young boy, Yusuf عليه السلام was thrown into a well by his brothers. Some travellers rescued him and sold him into slavery in Egypt to the King.



## King

Prophet Ishaq عليه السلام lived in Jerusalem and took care of Masjid Al Aqsa.

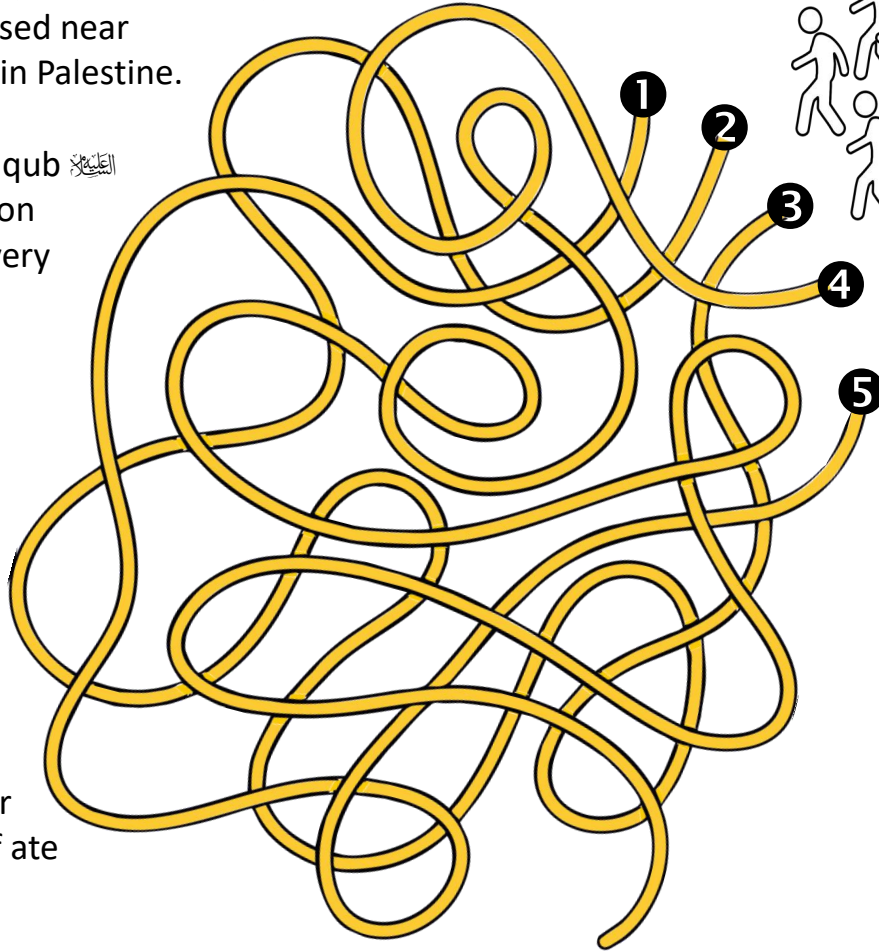
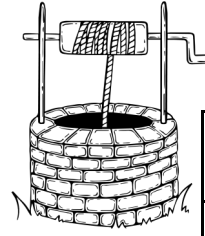

The King's wife wanted Yusuf عليه السلام to do something wrong but Yusuf عليه السلام refused. For this he was unjustly put into prison.

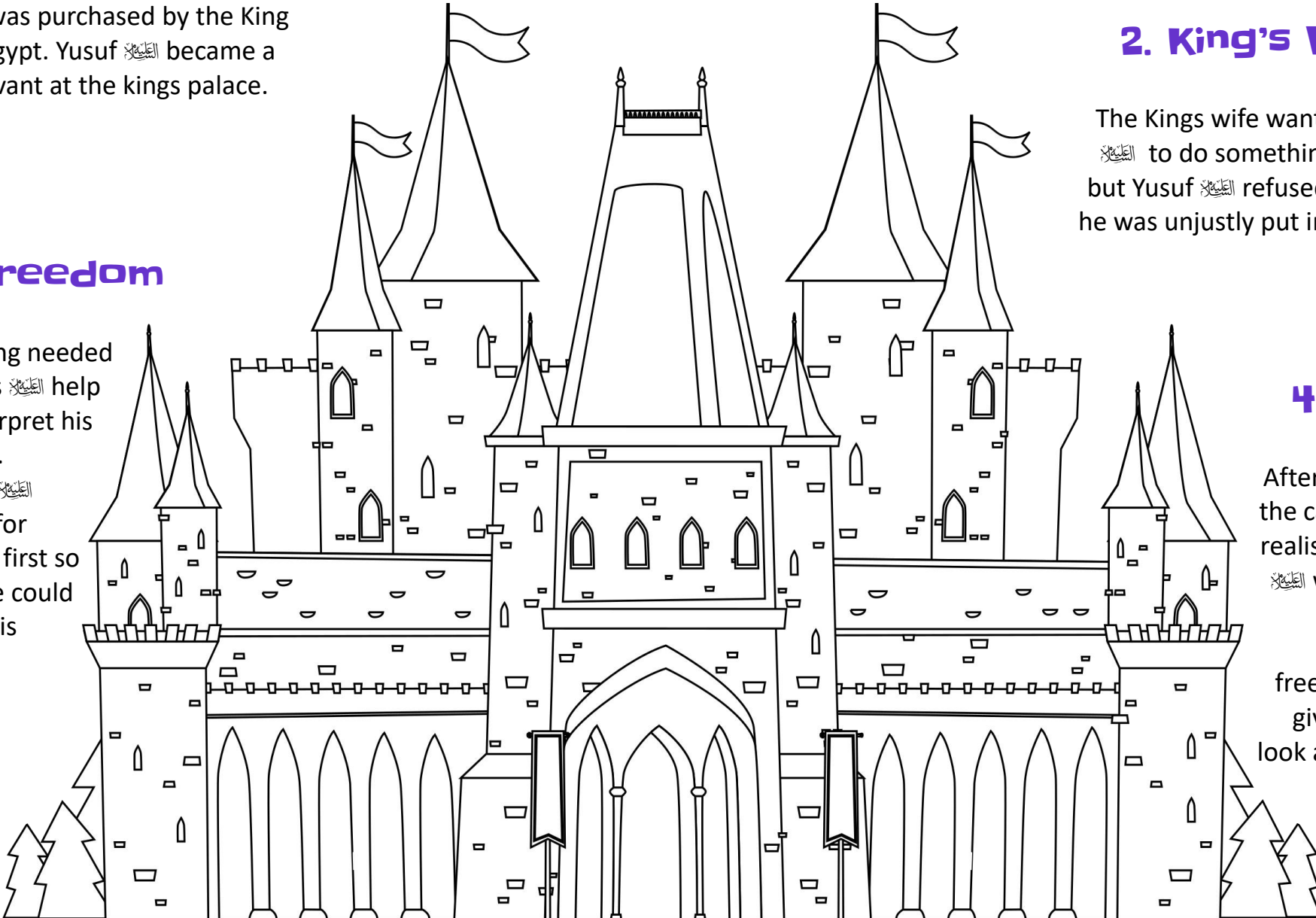
## 3. Freedom

The famine also effected the people in Jerusalem. The brothers of Yusuf عليه السلام went to Egypt to get food for their families.

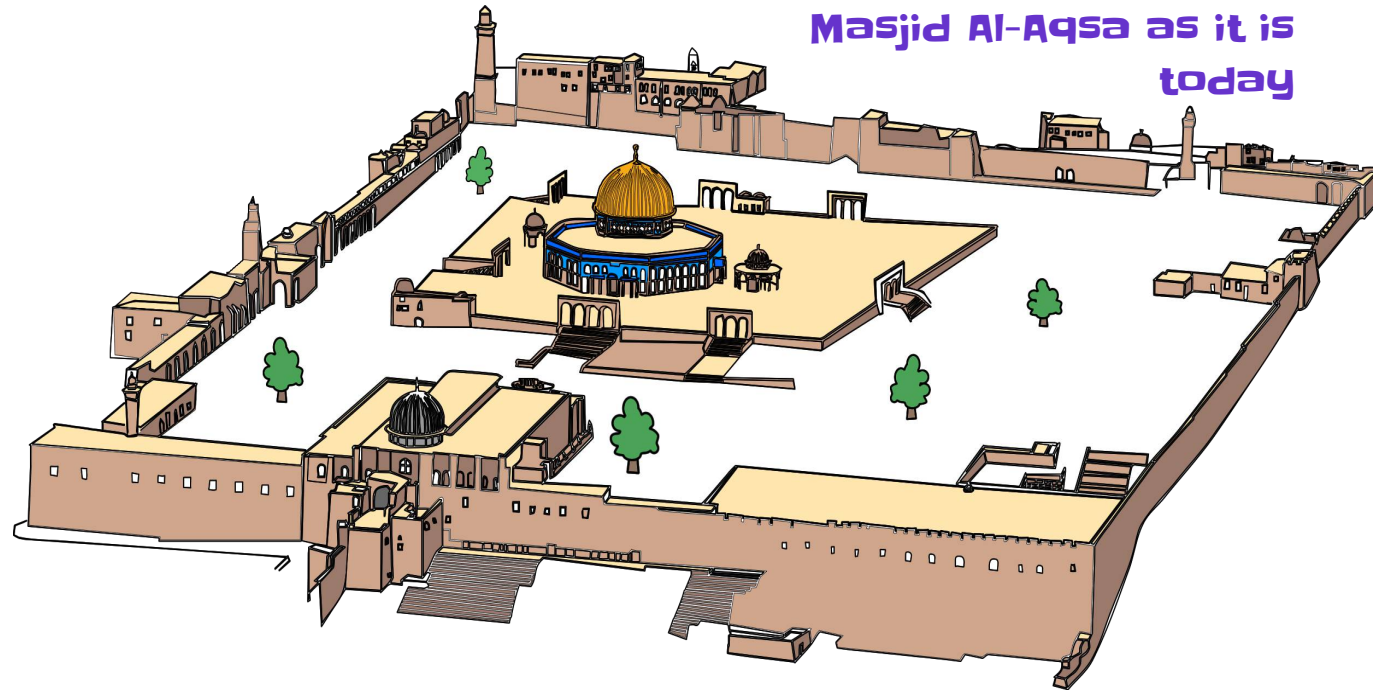
It was here, that Yusuf عليه السلام recognised his brothers and eventually invited them all to come and live with him in Egypt.

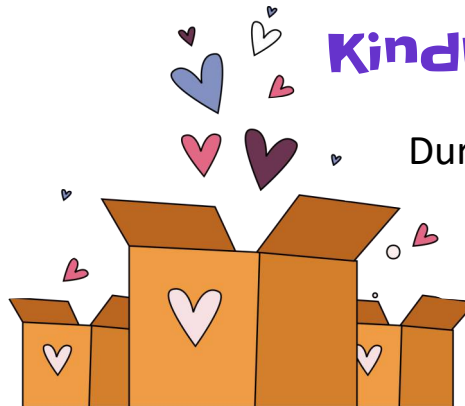
