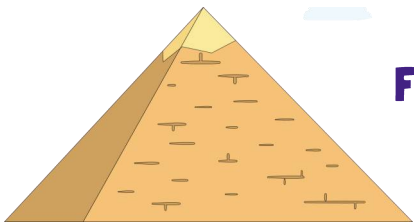
# The Story of Dawud عليه السلام ...

Yaqub عليه السلام (who was also called Israail) and his family moved to Egypt from Palestine. The children of Yaqub عليه السلام, were treated very badly by Pharaoh and his people. Musa عليه السلام was born during this time but Allah سبحانه وتعالى protected him by having Pharaoh's wife raise him. When Musa عليه السلام grew older, he saved his people from Pharaoh, and led them towards Palestine.



## Dawud عليه السلام

Dawud عليه السلام was a soldier who protected his people. When the Bani Israail fought against their enemy, Dawud عليه السلام made dua for Allah's help, and then defeated the enemy general Jalut (Goliath). After this, the Bani Israail returned to Jerusalem.



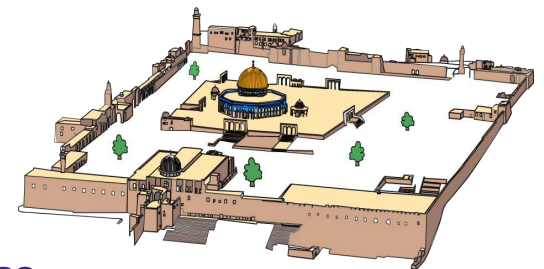
## Rebuilding Masjid Al-Aqsa

Prophet Dawud عليه السلام entered Jerusalem as the new king of the Bani Israail. He started to rebuild Masjid al-Aqsa but passed away before completing it. His son, Sulaiman عليه السلام, completed rebuilding Masjid Al-Aqsa.



## Sulaiman عليه السلام

Was the son of Dawud عليه السلام. Allah had blessed him with prophethood. Allah gave him the miracles of talking to animals, controlling the Jinn and also controlling the winds.



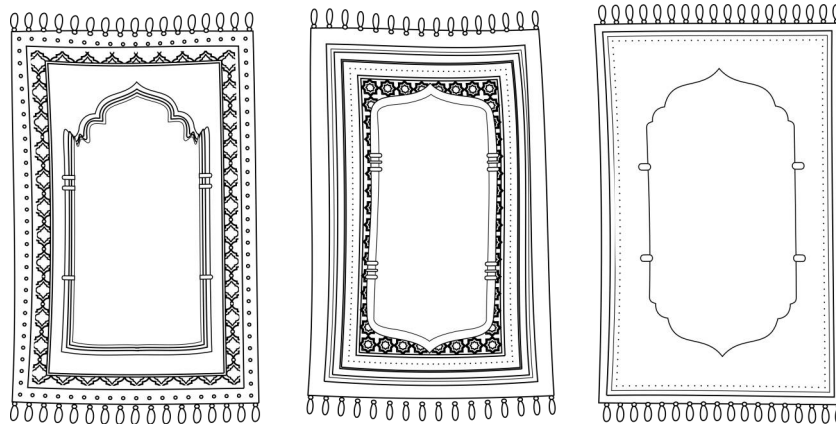
From Musa عليه السلام leaving Egypt until the completion of Masjid Al-Aqsa, it had taken a long time. However, the Masjid was once again completed and the people began worshipping Allah at this sacred place.

# Praying in Masjid Al-Aqsa

Prophet Dawud عليه السلام lived in Jerusalem for most of his life.

Dawud عليه السلام had great love for Masjid Al-Aqsa. When he became the king of Jerusalem, he started to rebuild Masjid Al-Aqsa which was in ruins.

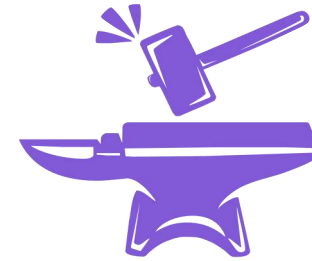
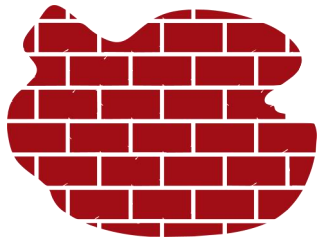
# Blessings of Dawud ﷺ

Allah gave Prophet Dawud ﷺ many blessings. The most important blessing was that Allah made him a prophet. Allah also made Dawud ﷺ a king amongst his people. People loved and respected him. Dawud ﷺ was a special teacher who taught them tawheed (believing in one God) and how to be good people.

Allah also gave him a book, the Zabur (psalms), as guidance for his people. Unfortunately, this message was changed and lost.

Whenever Dawud ﷺ did Zikr or recited the Zabur, the birds and mountains would join in. They would partake in this Zikr with the blessed voice of Dawud ﷺ. Allah also blessed Dawud ﷺ with working with metal. Allah would make the metal soft in his hands so he was able to make many things.

Allah allowed Dawud ﷺ to rebuild Masjid Al-Aqsa which was an honour and privilege. Prophet Dawud ﷺ was indeed a blessed and a very special prophet.

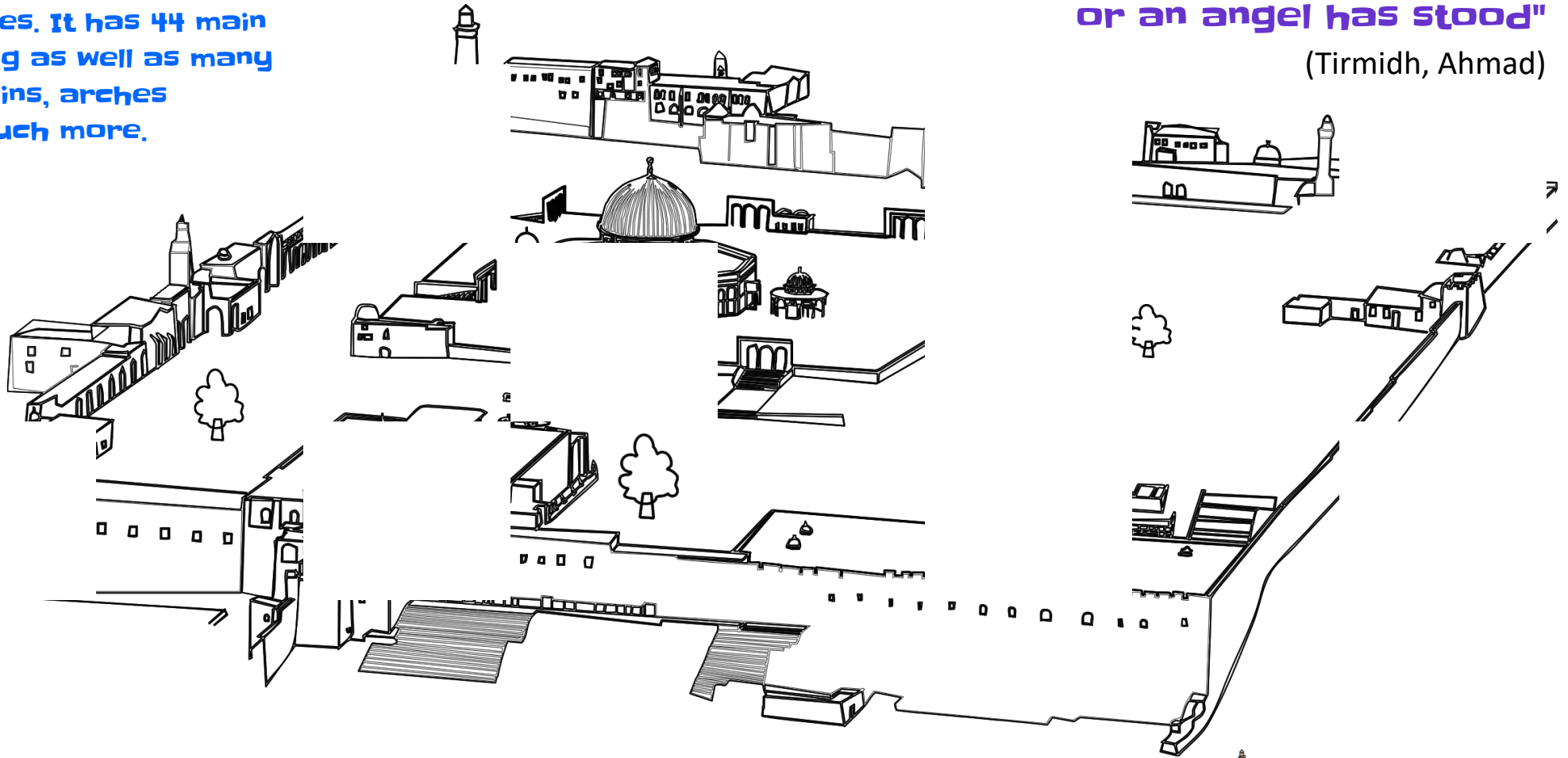

"Every single inch of Al-Aqsa is a place where a Prophet has prayed or an angel has stood"

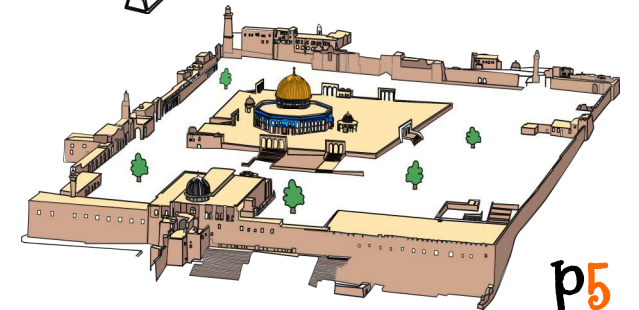

Prophet Dawud عليه السلام did not manage to finish the building of Masjid Al-Aqsa before he passed away.

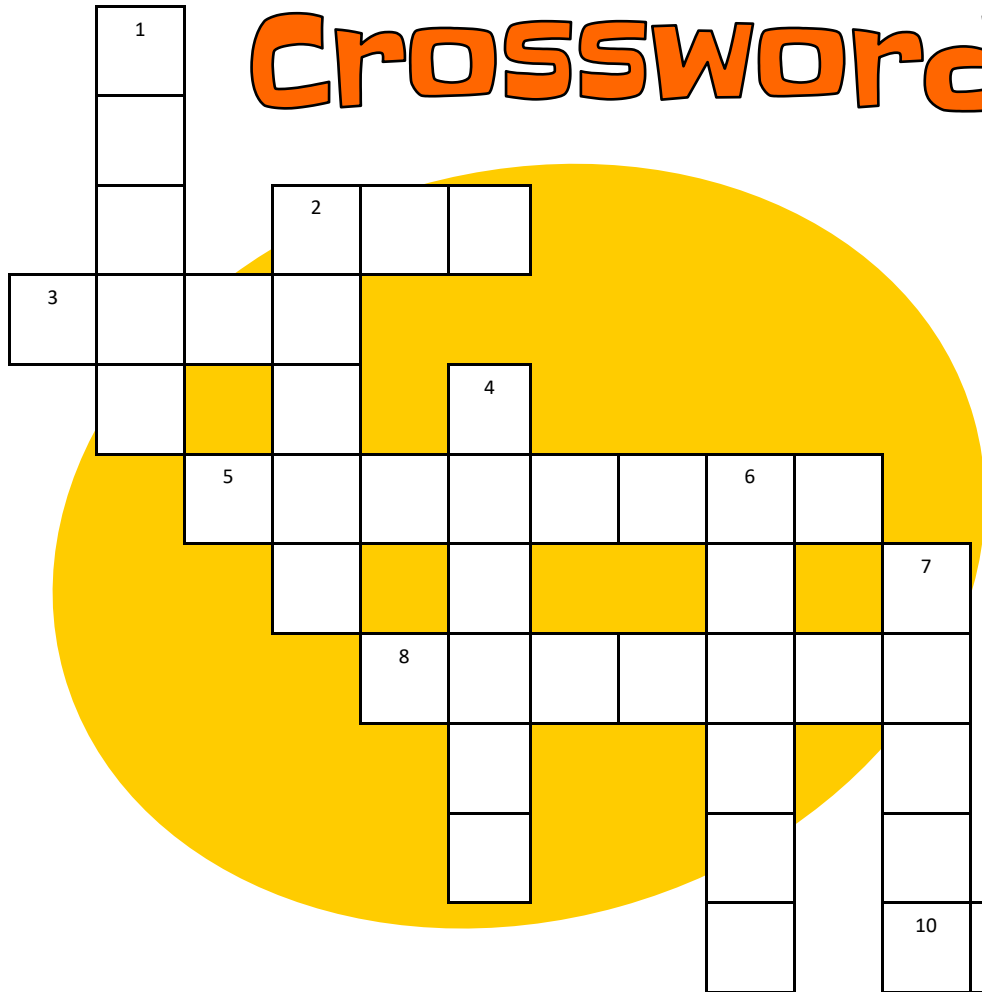
Prophet Dawud's عليه السلام son Prophet Sulaiman عليه السلام continued to build the Masjid until it was complete.

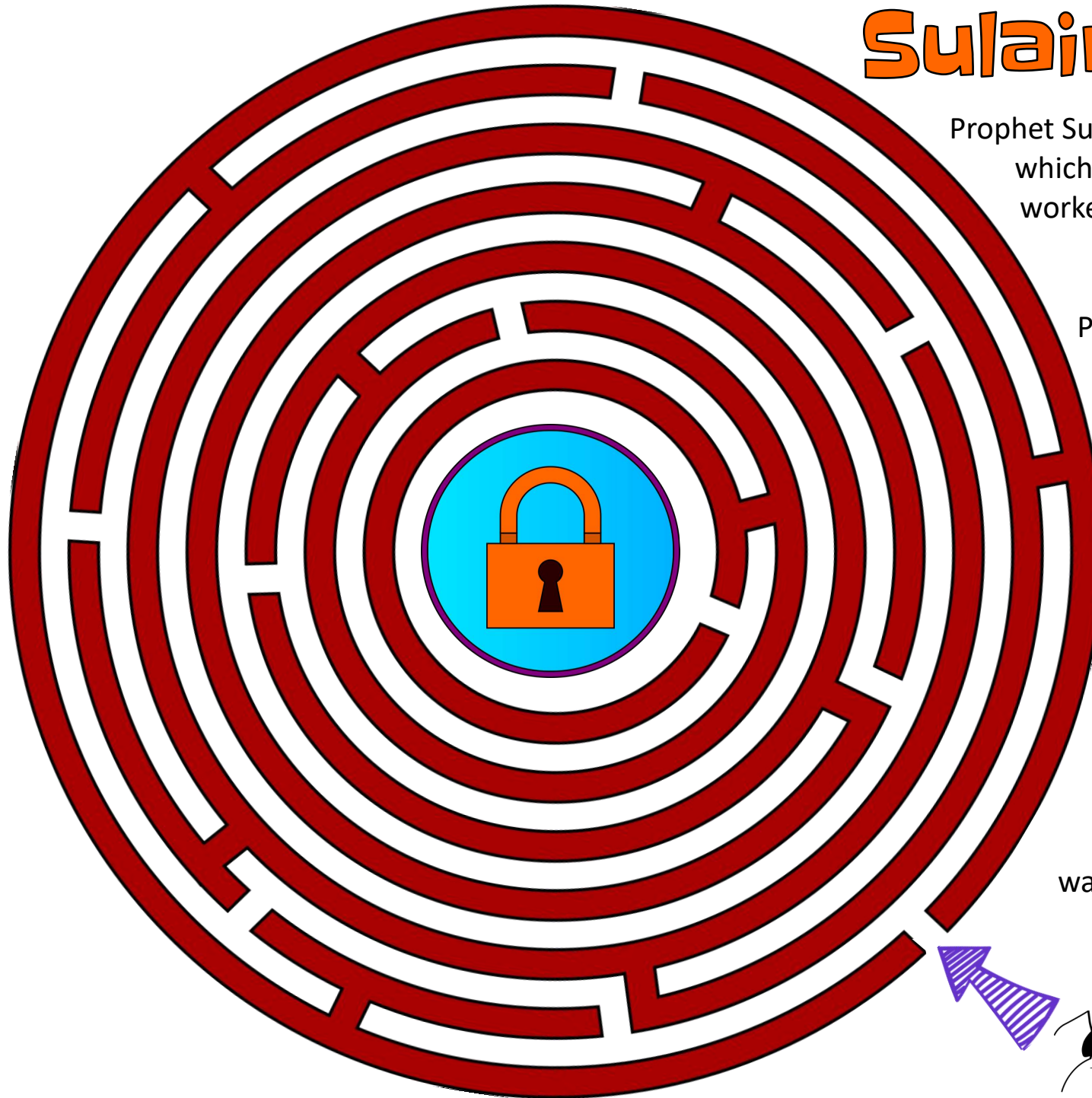
Prophet Sulaiman عليه السلام had the greatest kingdom ever seen. Masjid Al-Aqsa was the centre of this kingdom.

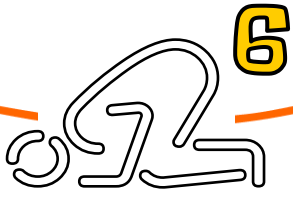
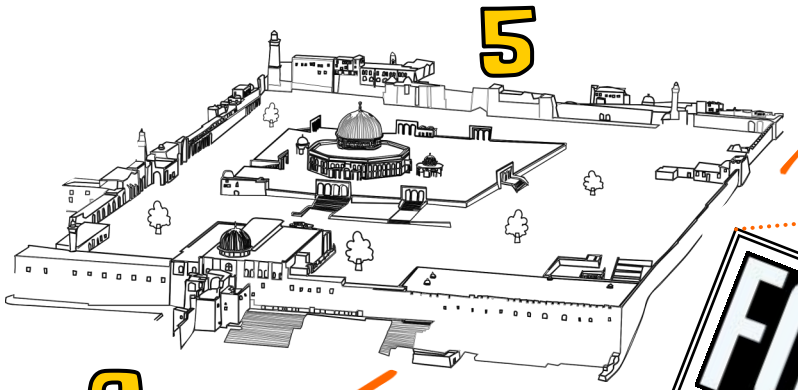
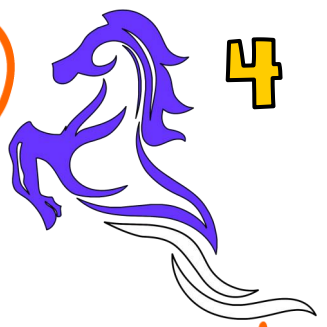
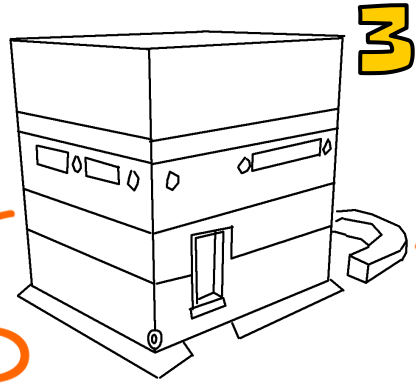
## Special Connection

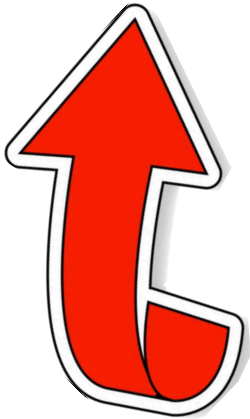

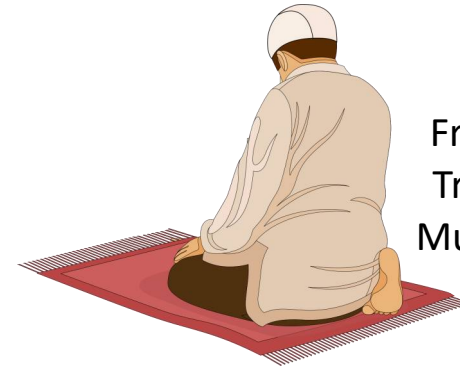
## Ascension

## Jannah

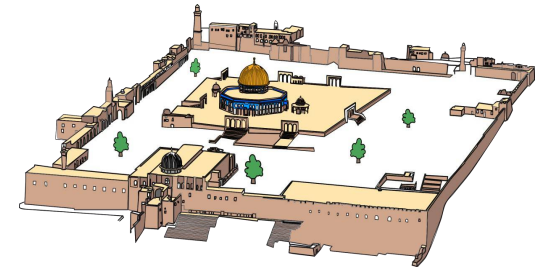

Our story begins when Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was praying **salah** with the **Sahabah** ﷺ. They were in Madina at a place which is now know as Masjid Qiblatayn.

Allah had commanded the Muslims to pray facing Masjid Al-Aqsa first, which was the **Qibla**. Qibla means direction of prayer. In those days, the Muslims prayed facing Masjid Al-Aqsa.

Allah commanded our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ to change the **direction** of prayer facing the Ka'bah in Makkah.

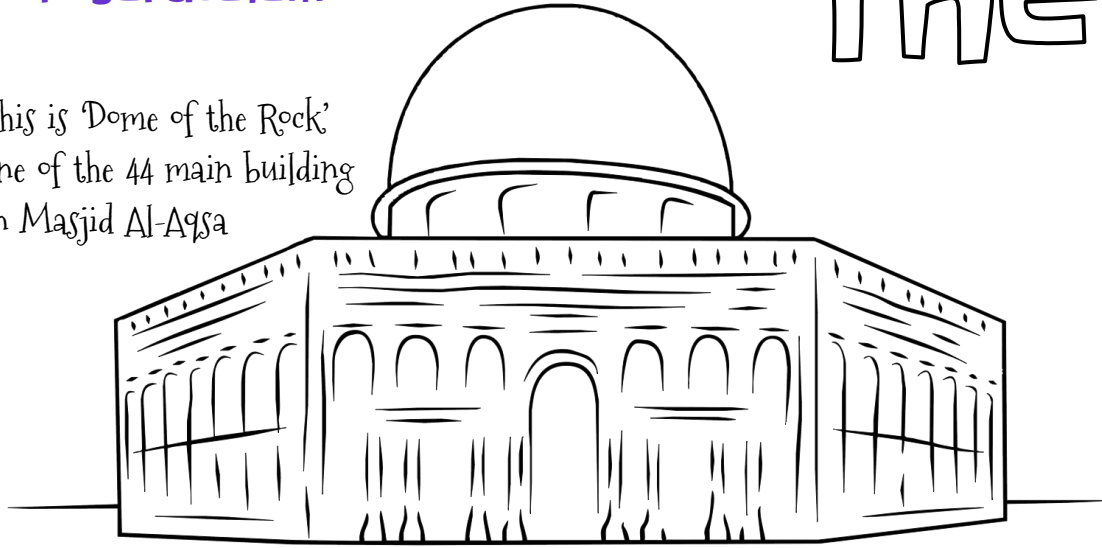
Our Prophet **Muhammad** ﷺ immediately changed direction towards the **Ka'bah**. The Sahabah ﷺ who were praying behind him also changed their direction towards the Ka'bah.

The Ka'bah was now the new Qibla. The Masjid Qiblatayn is known as the **masjid** with two Qiblas - Masjid Al-Aqsa and the Ka'bah.

When we visit **Madina**, be sure to visit and **pray** in this amazing Masjid - Masjid Qiblatayn.

## Prophets

# 3

## The Command of Salah

Allah ﷻ sent many commands for the Muslims to follow. Allah would send these through Angel Jibra'il to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ through Wahi (revelation).

Salah is so special that Allah called Prophet Muhammad ﷺ to Him and gave the command for the five daily prayers. This shows the important Salah.

# 4

## Hardship

Allah ﷻ will test us all with hardships and difficulties, just like He tested our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

We should be patient, keep working hard and make lots of Dua. This is the sunnah of our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and Sahabah ﷺ.
