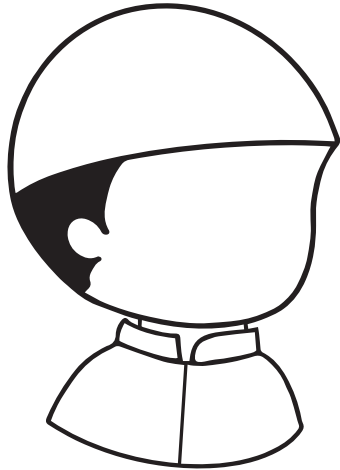

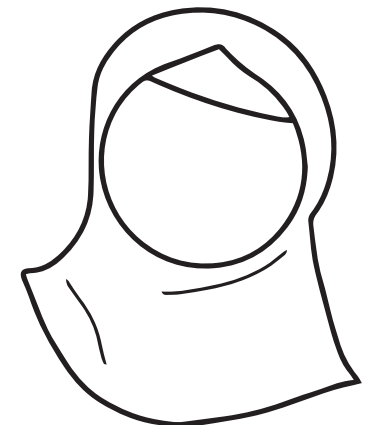
FUN FACTS



Did you know Masjid Al-Aqsa was the first Qibla? Qibla is the direction we face when we pray Salah.



Masjid Al-Aqsa and its surroundings have been mentioned over **80** times in the Quran!



THE QIBLA



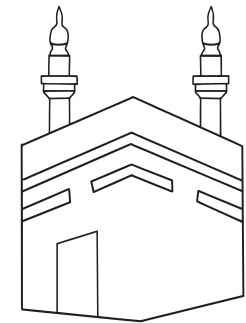
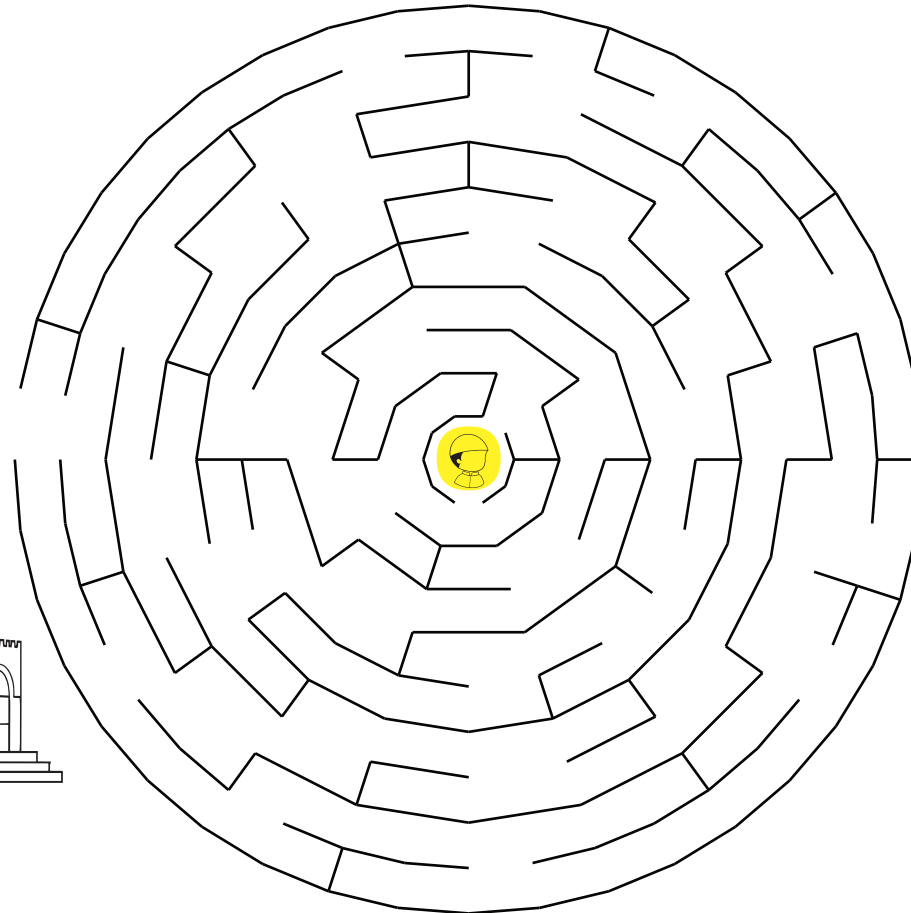
For over **14 YEARS** Muslims prayed Salah facing Masjid Al-Aqsa.

Masjid Al-Aqsa was the Qibla for **13 YEARS** when the Prophet ﷺ lived in Maḳkah.

After the Prophet ﷺ moved to Madina, Masjid Al-Aqsa was the Qibla for **16-17 MONTHS**.

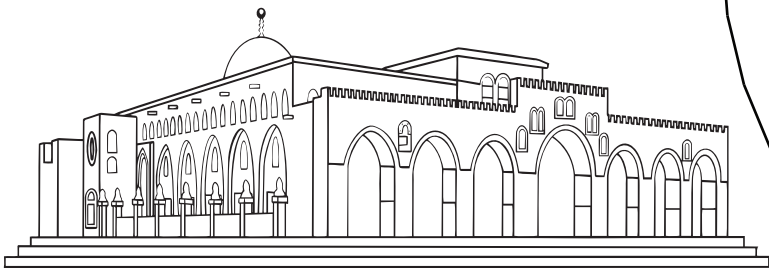
After this, they prayed towards the Ka'ba in Maḳkah, like we do today!

Can you help the person find the first Qibla (Masjid Al-Aqsa)?

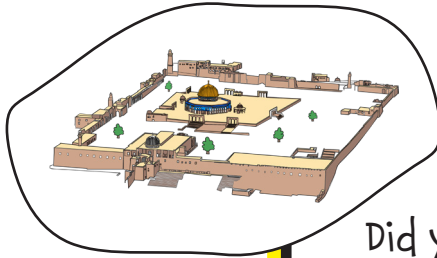
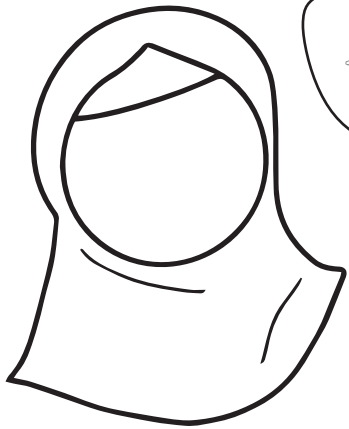
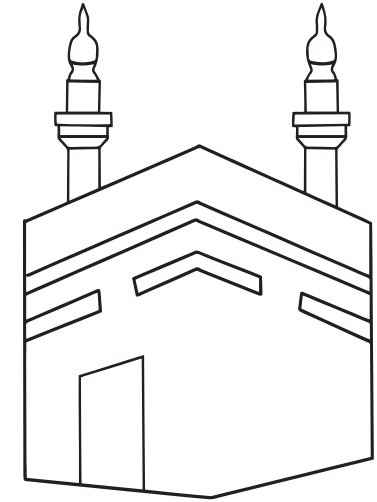
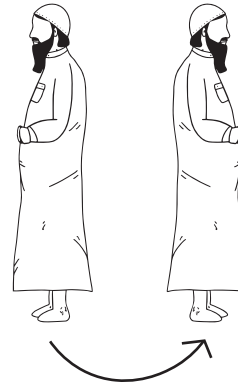
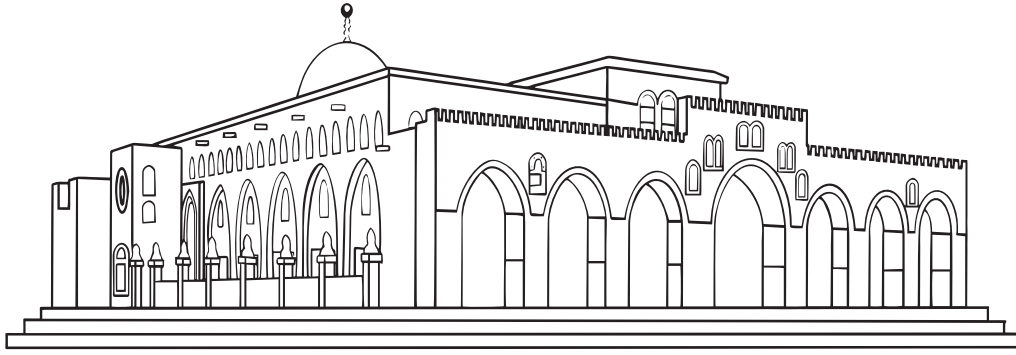


For an extra challenge, can you help the person find the final Qibla (the Ka'ba)?

Make sure you use two different colour pens!

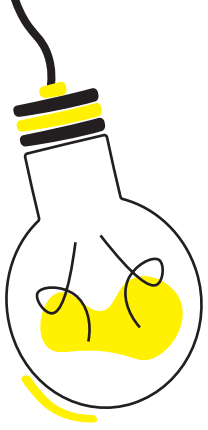
